## Overview of New Census Data



## MARRI's Examination of Wellbeing in America

## <u>Upward Mobility and</u> <u>Family Structure</u>

Findings from the census data reveal that the number of two-parent families in children's local population increase chances of upward considerably. The share of single-parent households also strongly decreases children's chances of upward mobility.
