
Decline in Marriage Increases Rate of Uninsured

The change in marriage patterns between 1988 and 2008 have contributed to higher non-insurance rates, particularly for men, <u>reports</u> Christine Percheski of Northwestern University.



Divorce Increases Risk of Stroke

Divorced adults—especially men—have an increased risk for getting a stroke, <u>according</u> to researchers at the 3rd European Stroke Organization Conference (ESOC).



Pornography Viewers in Australia

Eighty-seven percent of Australians aged 18 to 29 years old had ever viewed pornography. More frequent pornography viewing was linked with being male, being younger, having a higher education, having a non-heterosexual identity, ever having anal intercourse and recent mental health problems, <u>report</u> researchers at Burnet Institute in Australia.
