

Marriage and Domestic Violence*

Social science research demonstrates that marriage reduces domestic violence:


- Marriage is the safest environment for adult women.
- Married women are much less likely than cohabiting women to be abused by their partner.
- Married men are less likely to murder their partner than cohabiting men.
- Domestic violence against married mothers is lower than domestic violence against always-single mothers.

Marriage benefits women and communities. What one thing can you do to share this information with community leaders?

The following chart shows that married mothers are far less likely than mothers from any other family structure, particularly those that have never been married, to experience domestic violence.


