




Connecticut Fraction of Families Intact





fraction of all births





fraction of 19- to 20- year-olds





fraction of 25- to 54- year- old men working





average per 25- to 54- year- old male





Fraction of households owning home





fraction of overall population





fraction of 25- to 54- year- old females




Connecticut Persons below poverty line, fraction of minors




Connecticut Food stamp recipients, fraction of households





average per 25- to 54- year- old female




Connecticut Social Security Disability Income, average per 25- to 54- year- old




Connecticut Social Security Disability Income, average per 25- to 54- year- old male




Connecticut Supplemental Security Income (SSI), average per 25- to 54- year- old male






