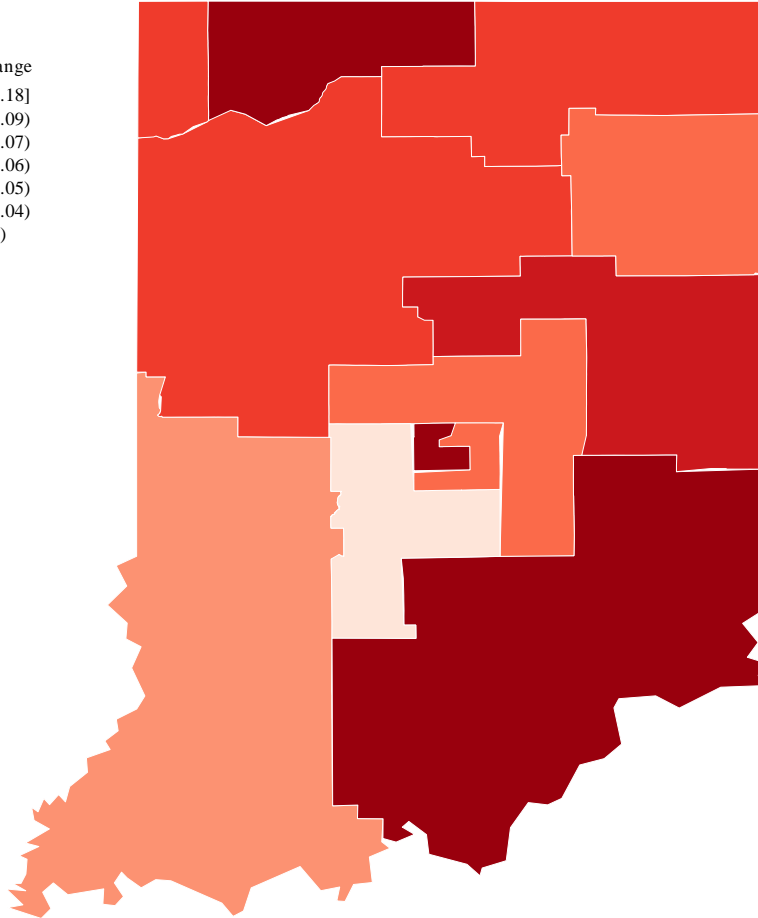

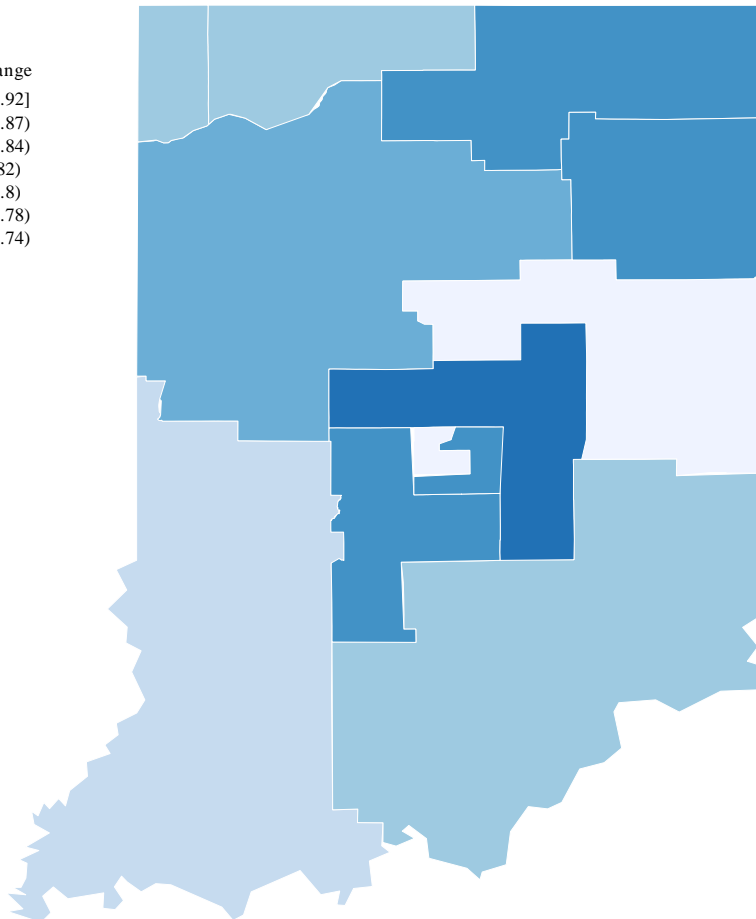

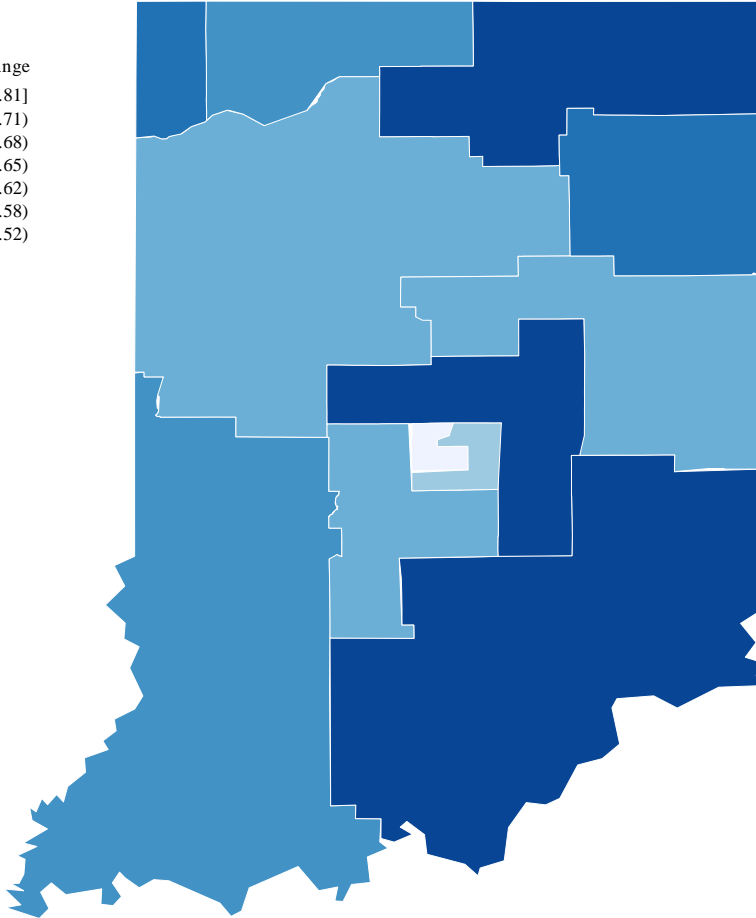
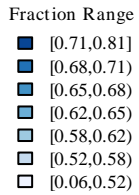
Earnings,

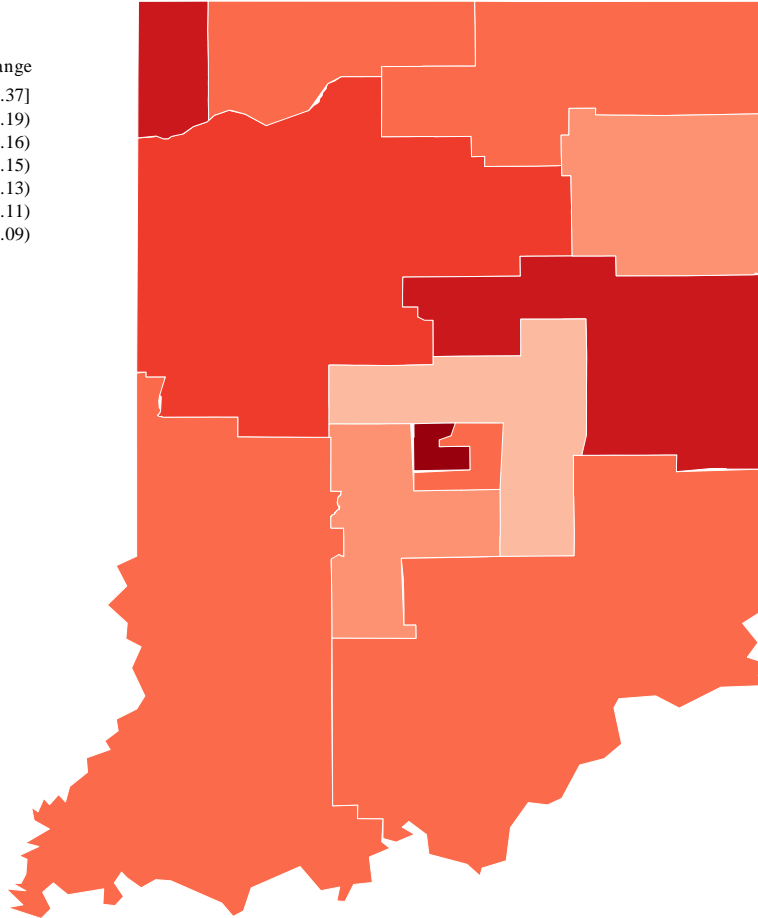

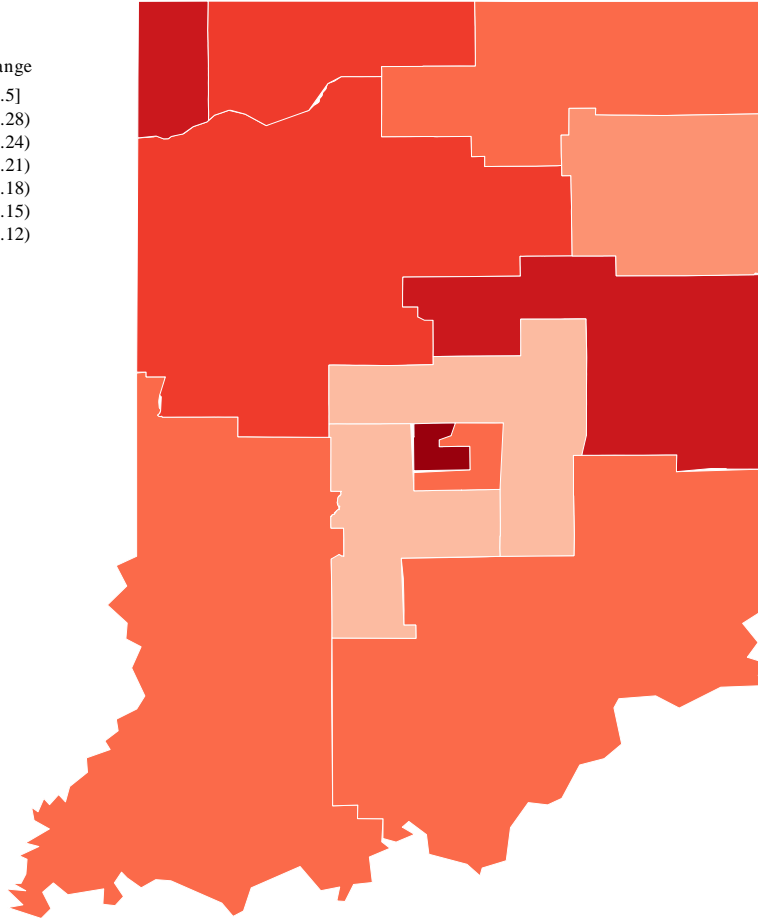

Food stamp recipients, fraction of households

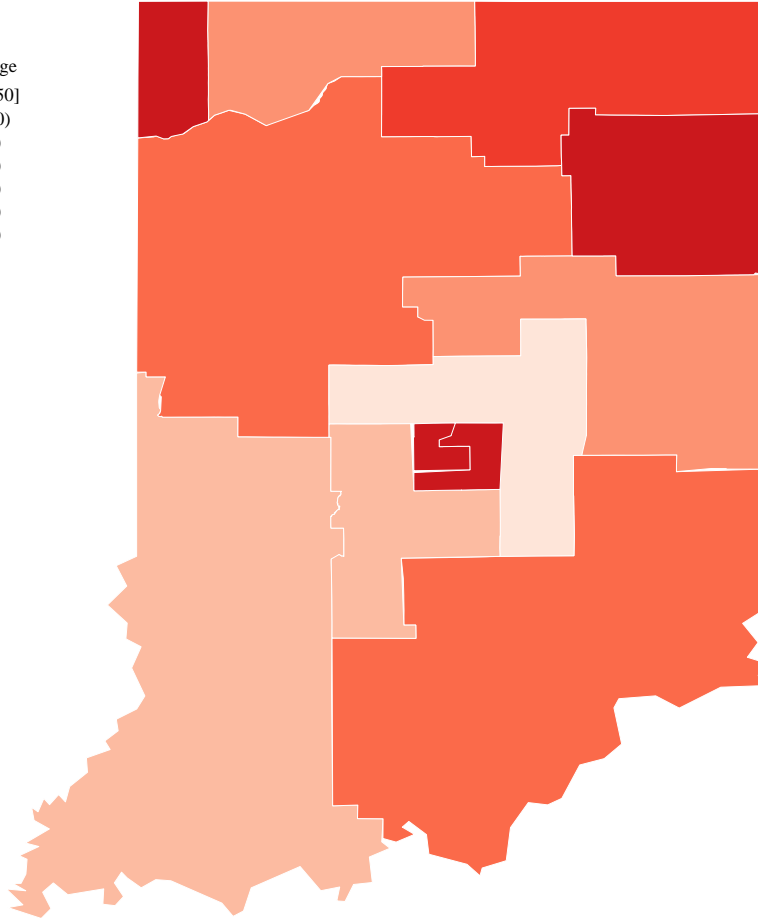
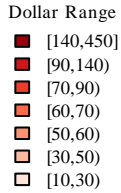

TANF & state welfare transfers, average per 25- to 54- year- old female

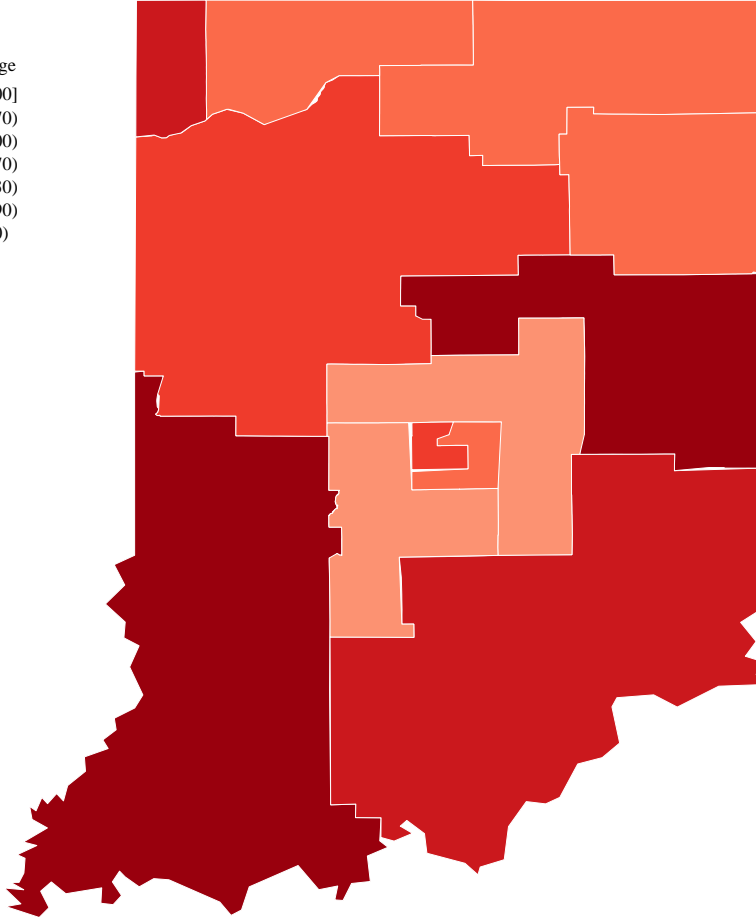

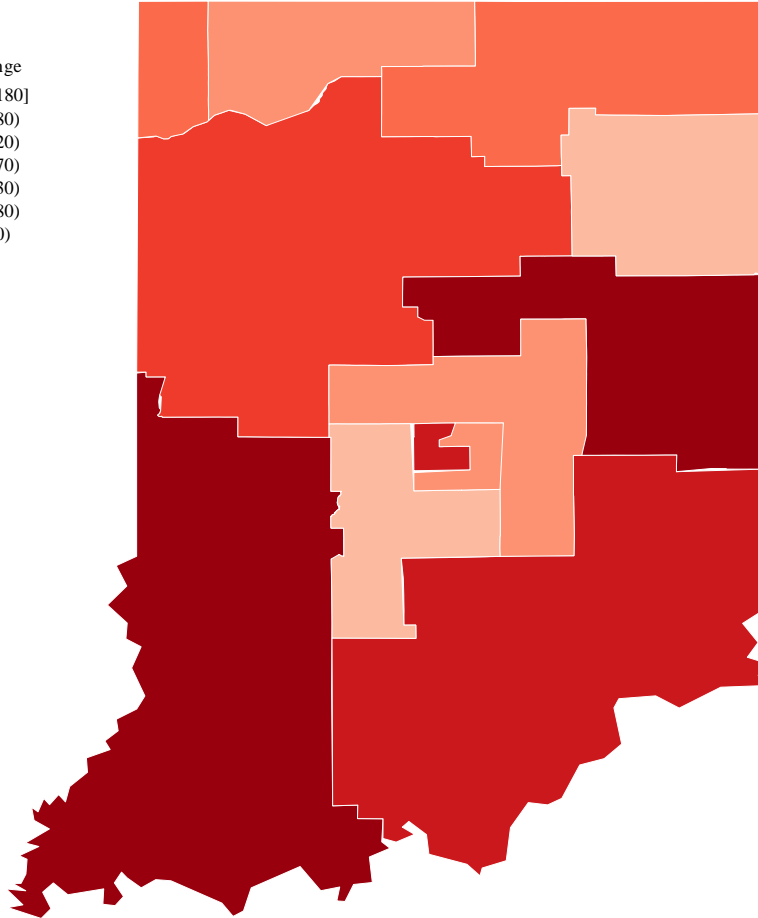

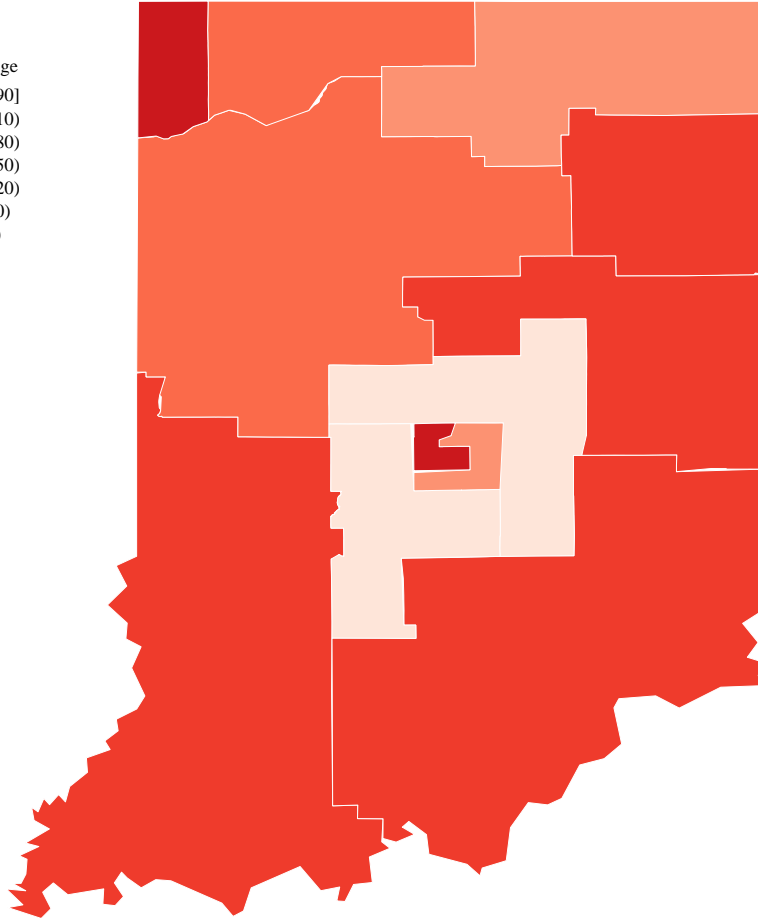

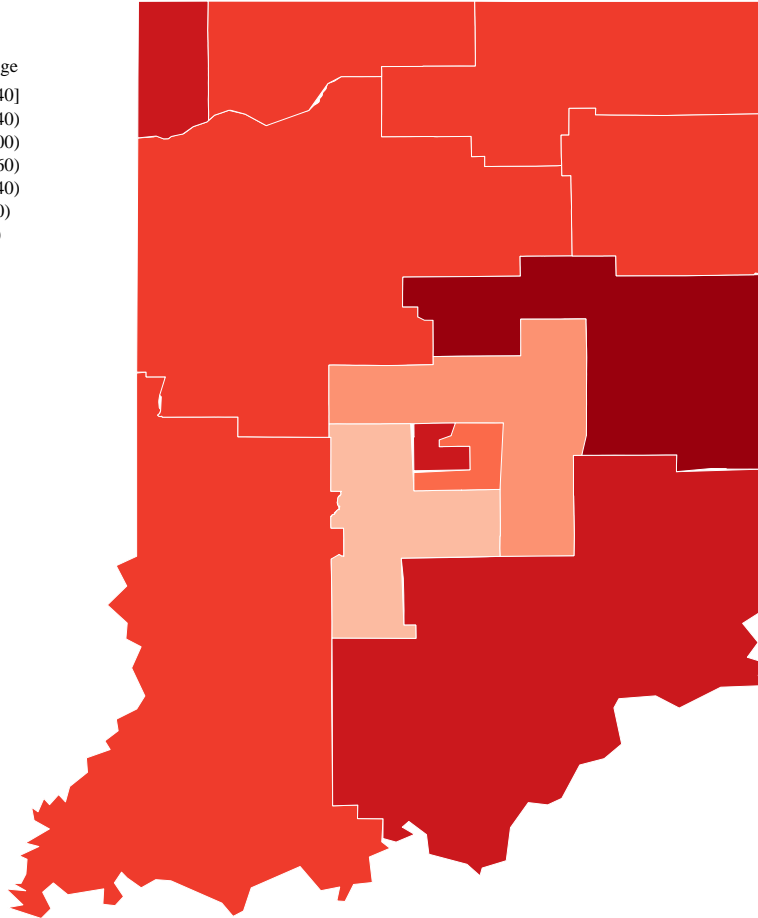

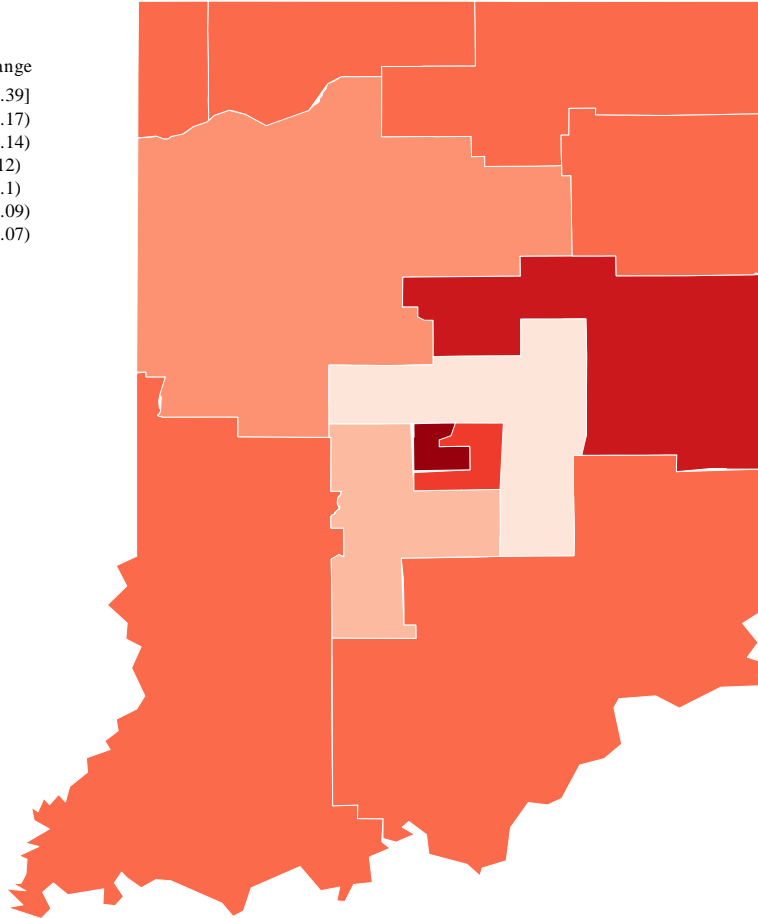

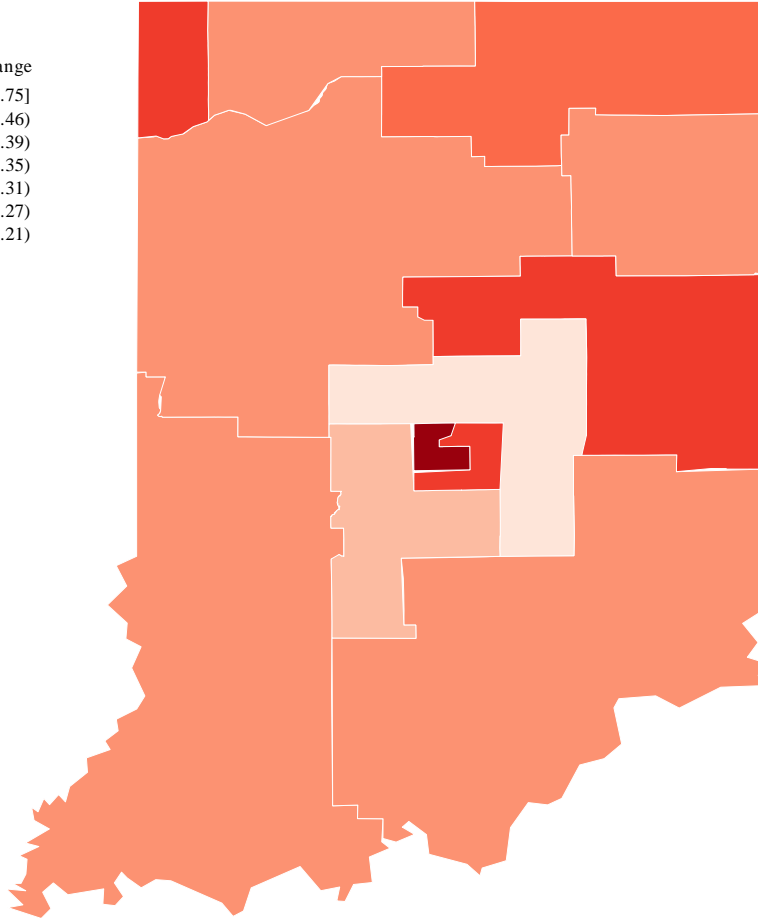

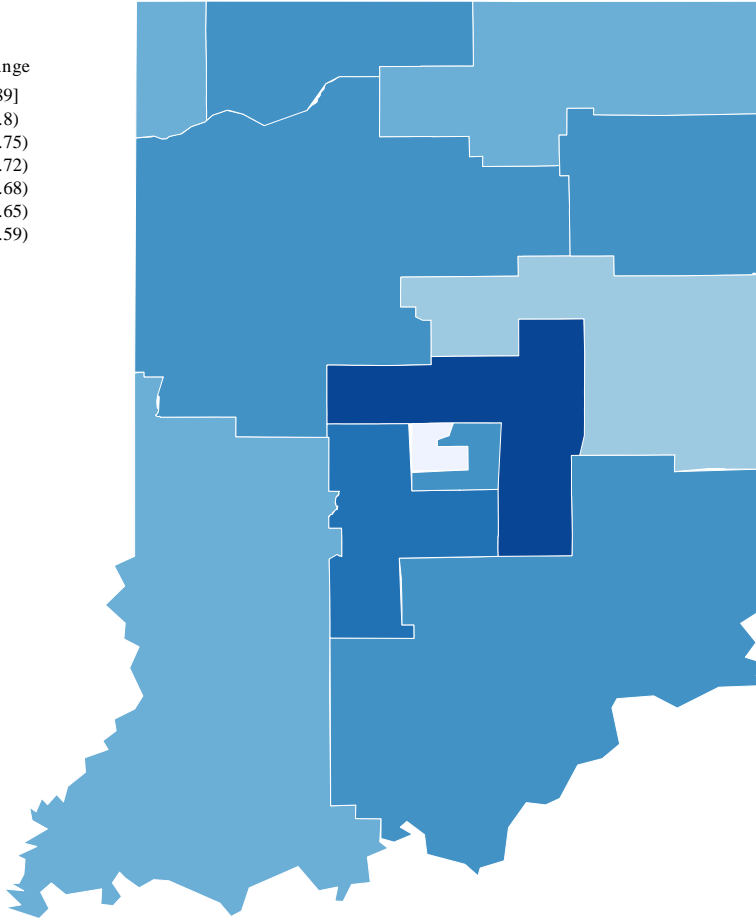
