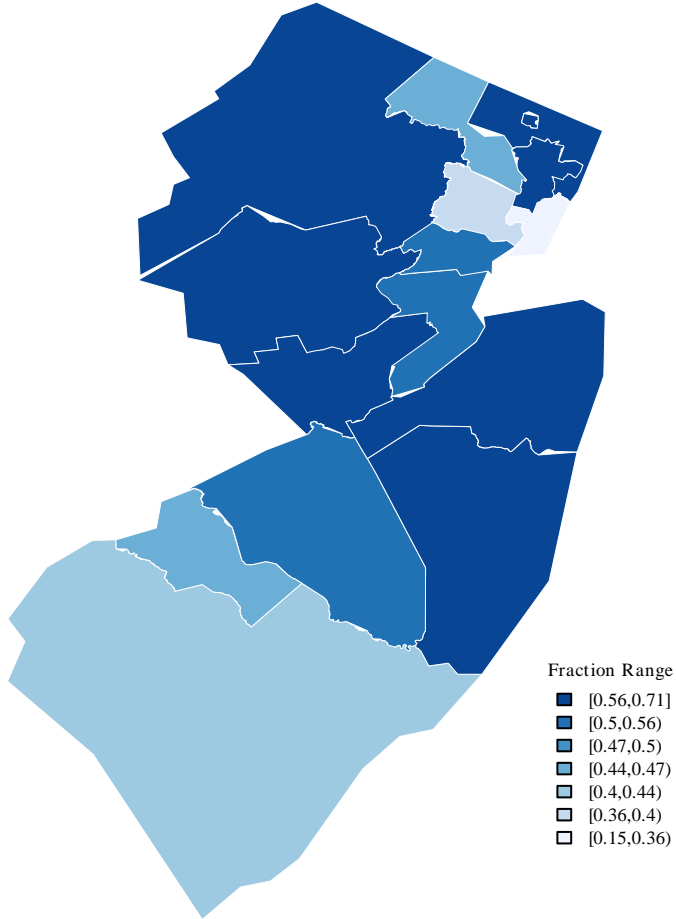

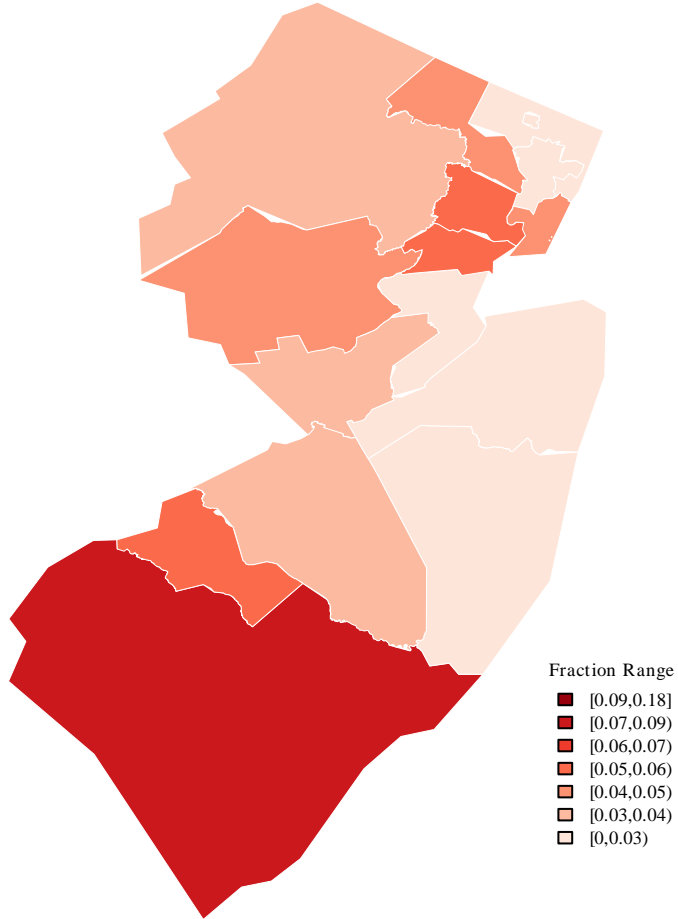

## Fraction of Families Intact

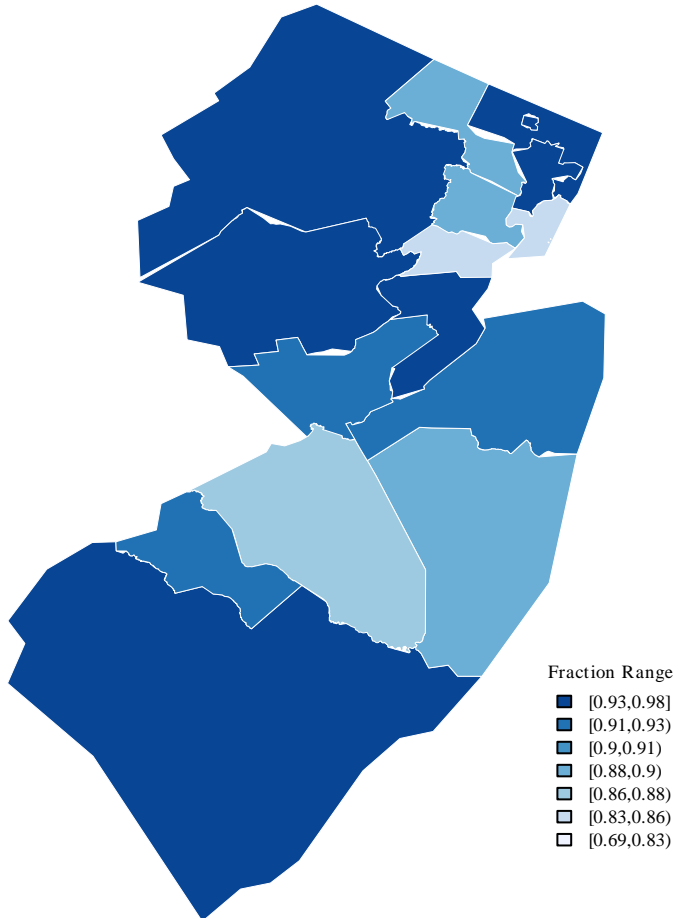

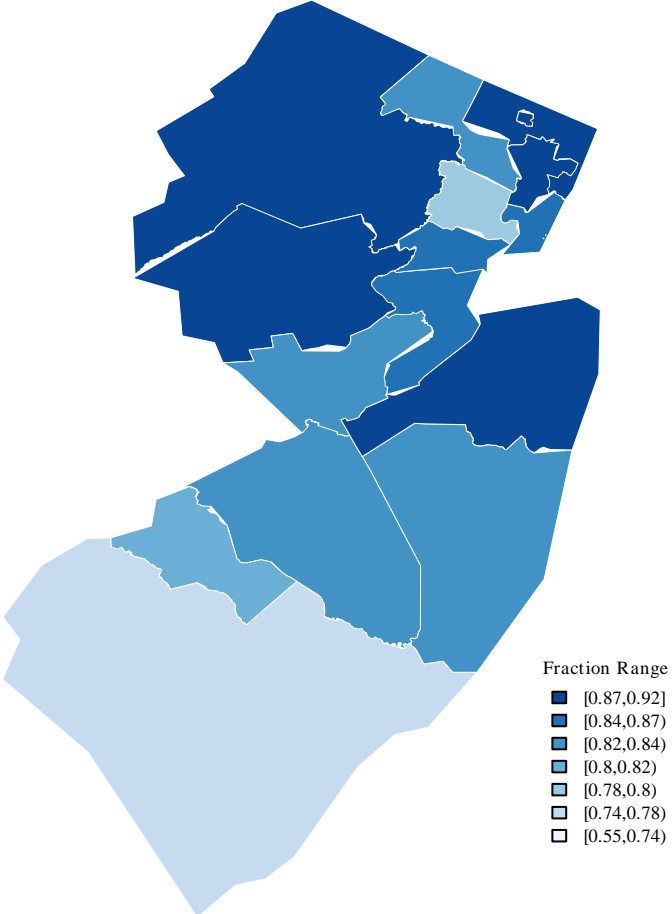
## Teenage out-of-wedlock births, fraction of all births



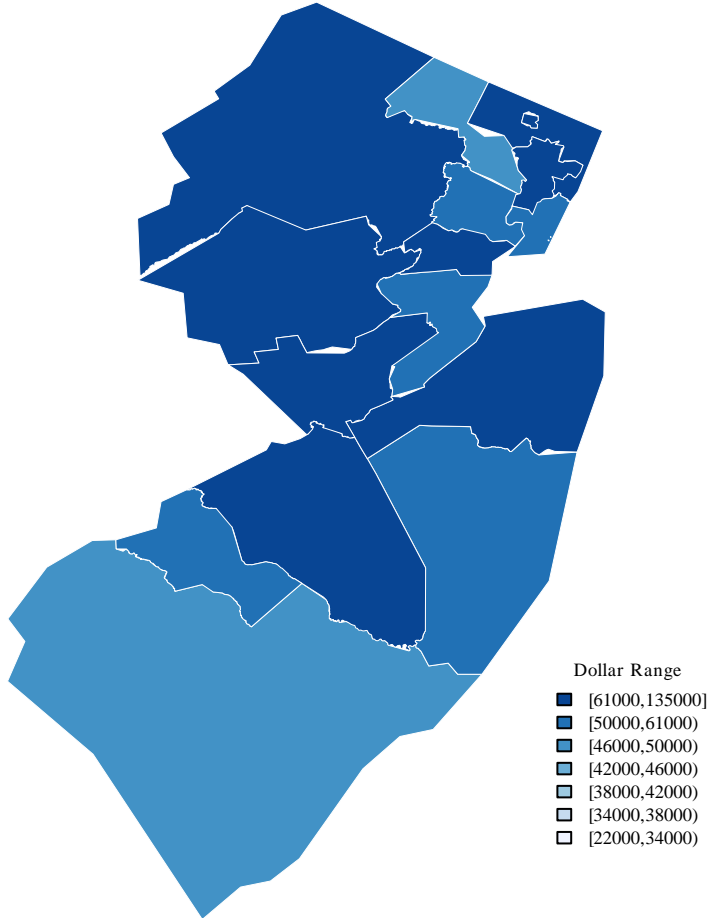

fraction of 25- to 54- year- old men working

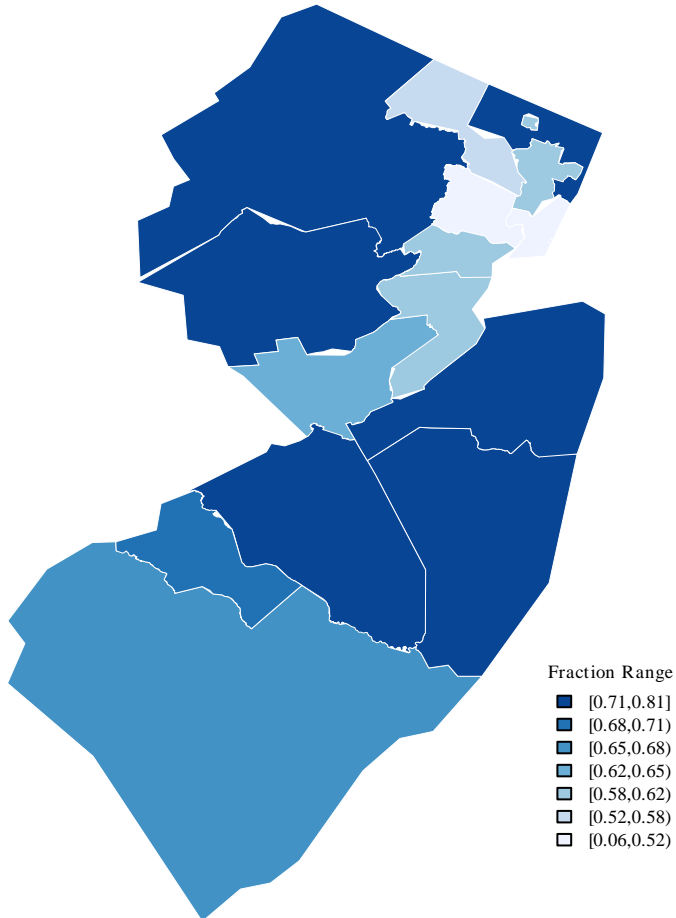

average per 25- to 54- year- old male



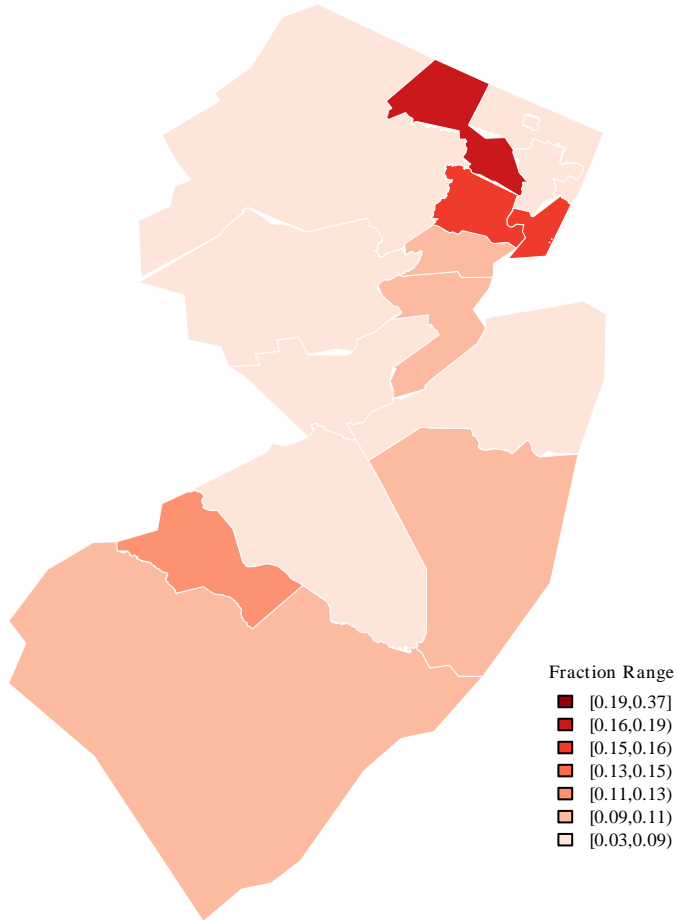

## Fraction of households owning home



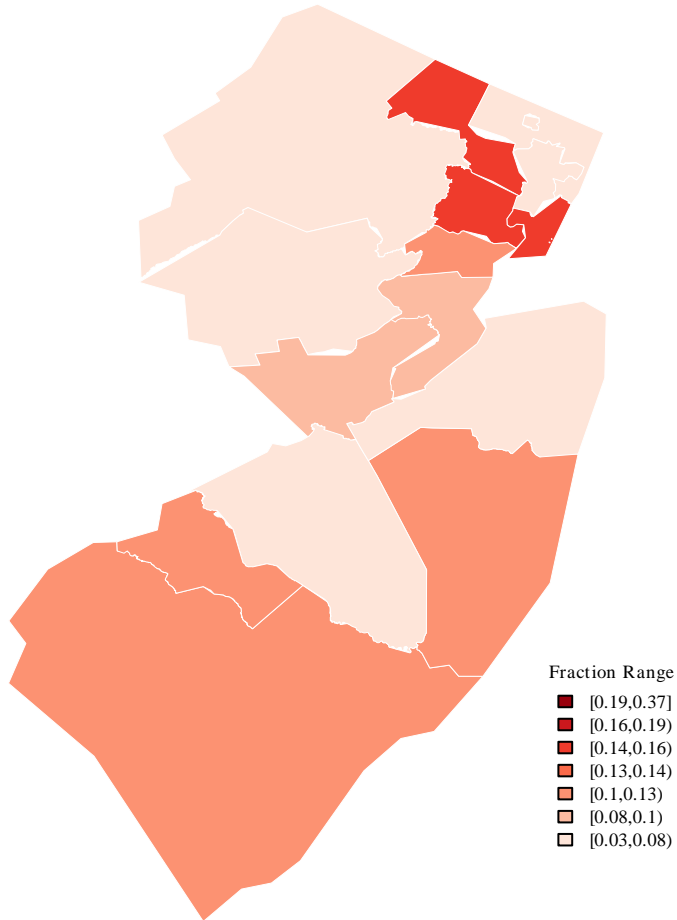

## Persons below poverty line, fraction of overall population



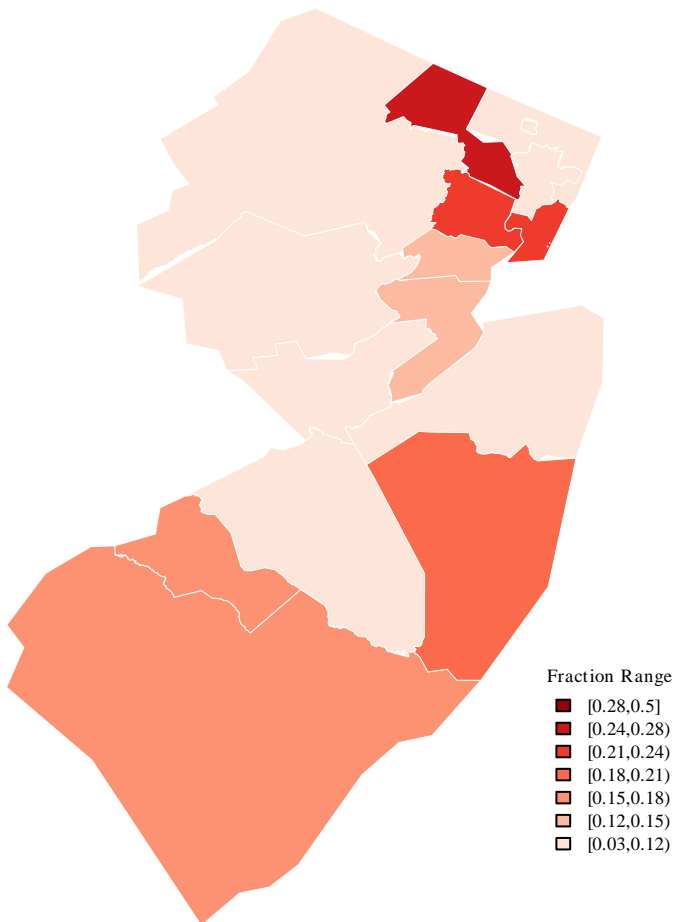

fraction of 25- to 54-year-old females



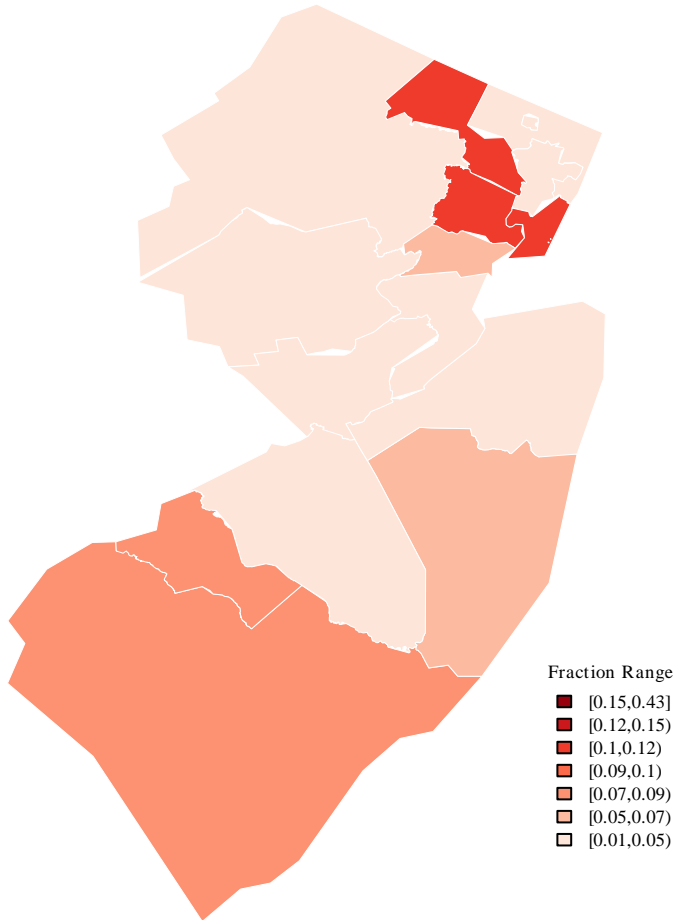

## Persons below poverty line, fraction of minors

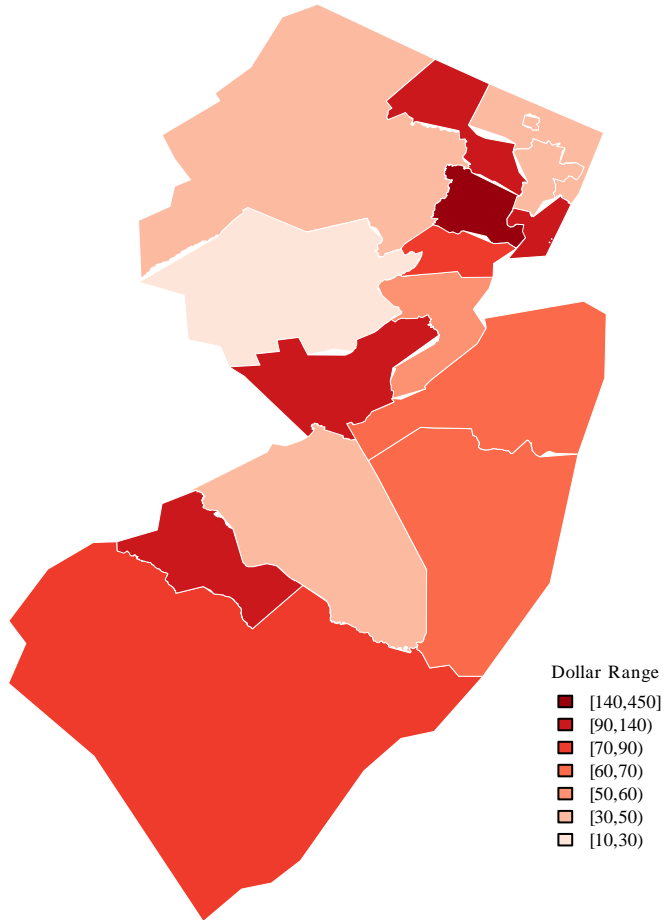

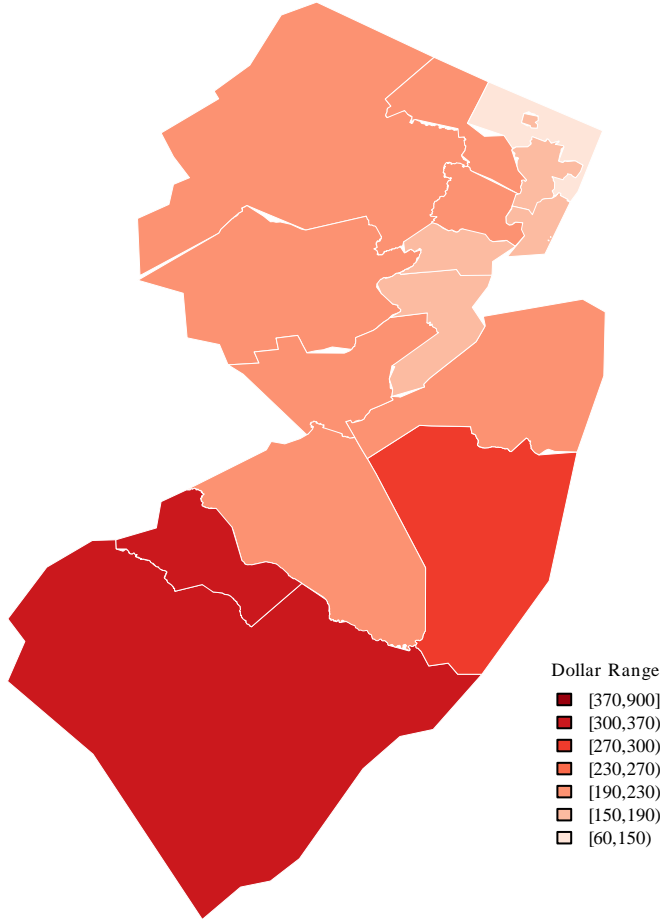
## Food stamp recipients, fraction of households



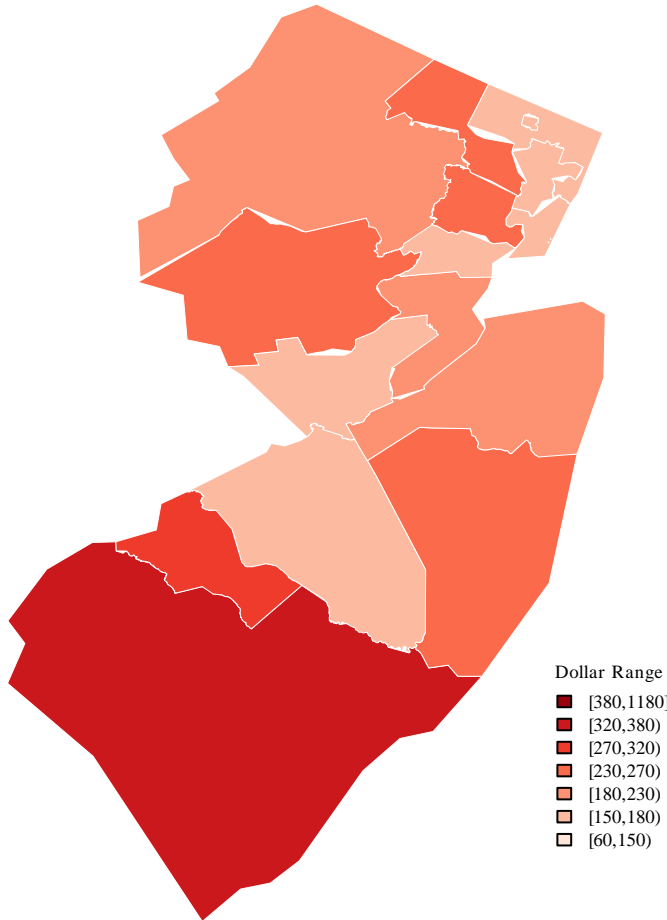

average per 25- to 54- year- old female



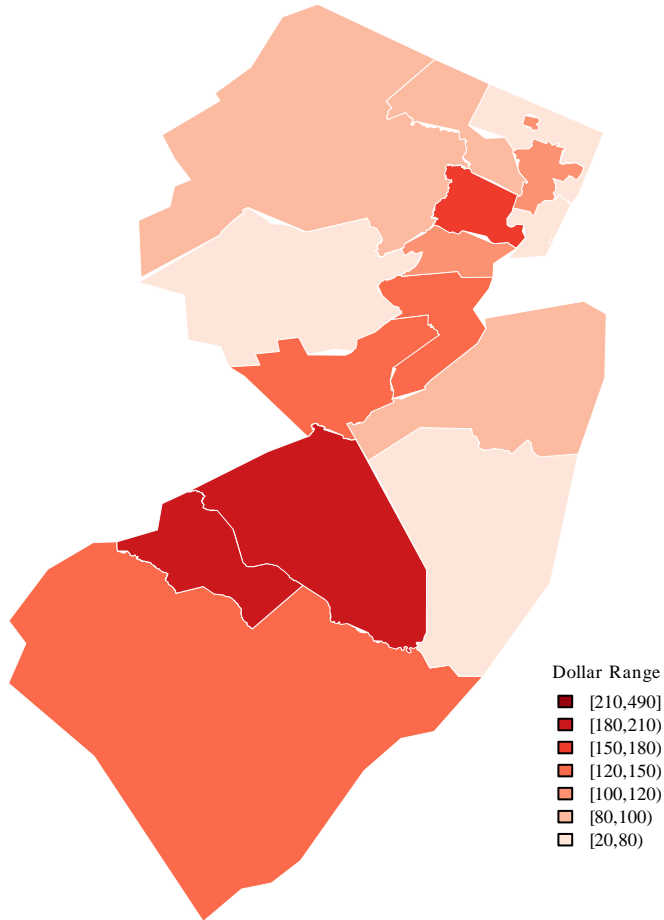

average per 25- to 54-year-old



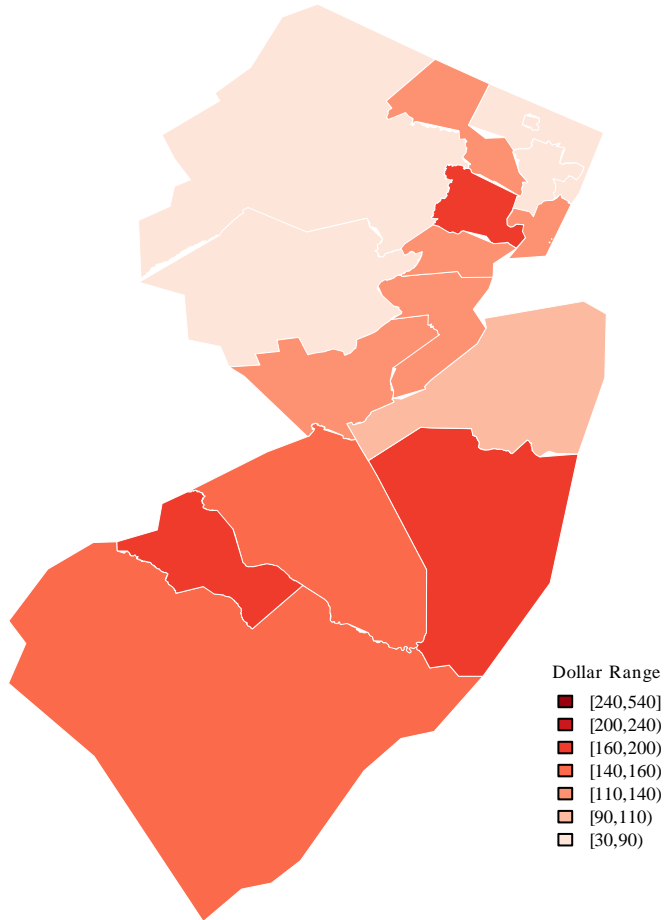

average per 25- to 54- year- old male

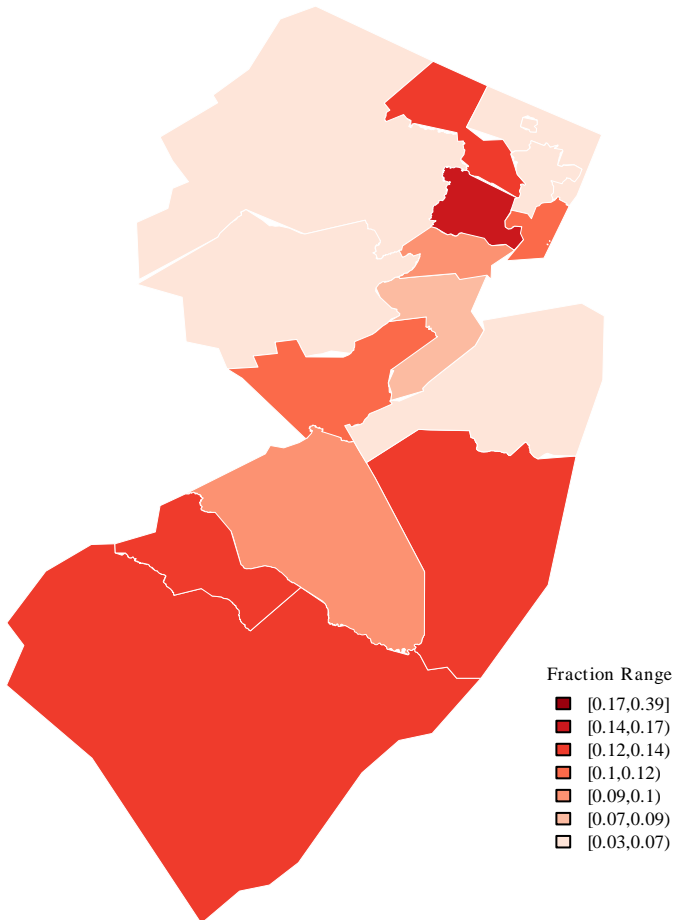

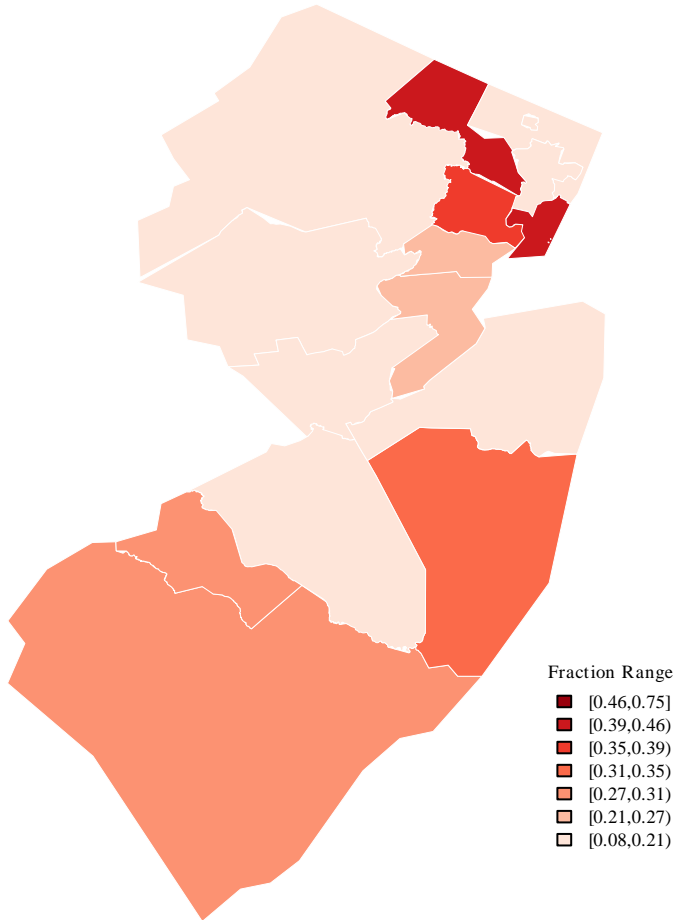




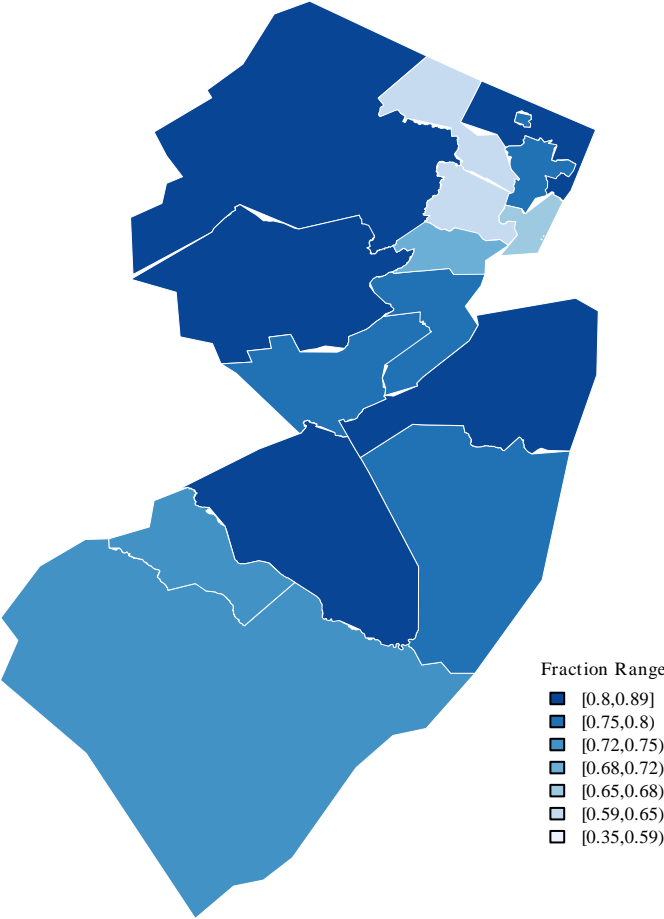
