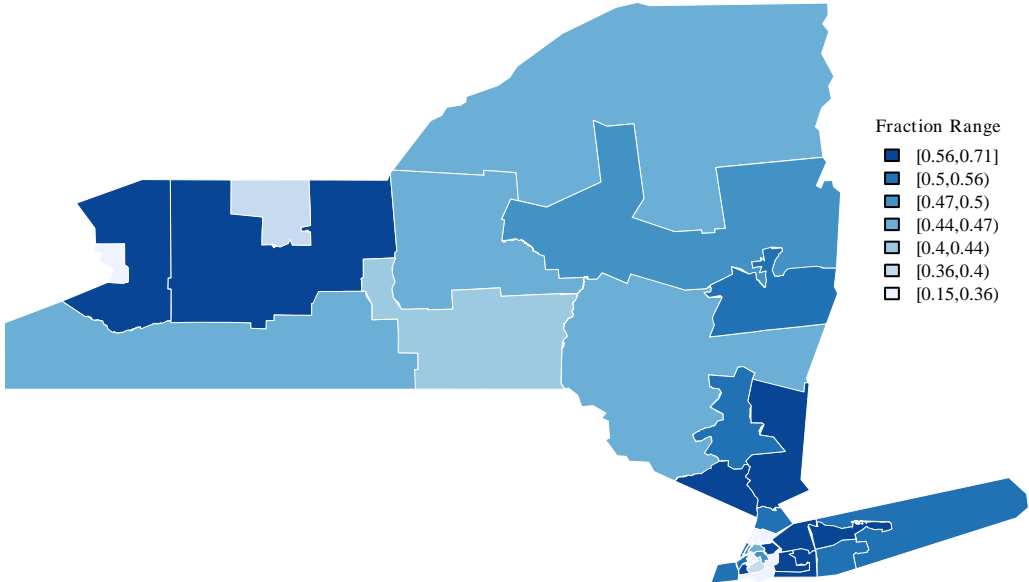

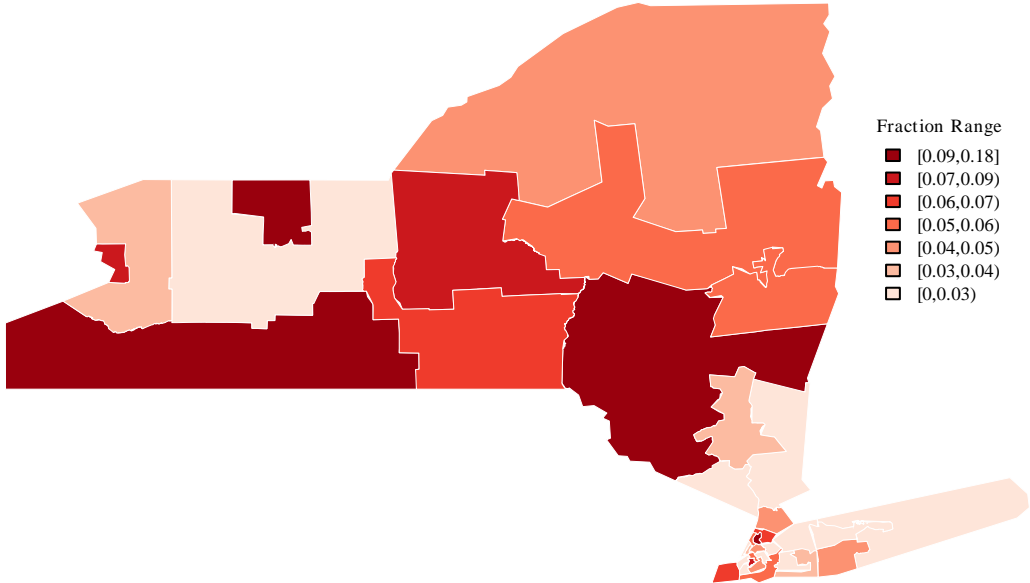

Fraction of Families Intact

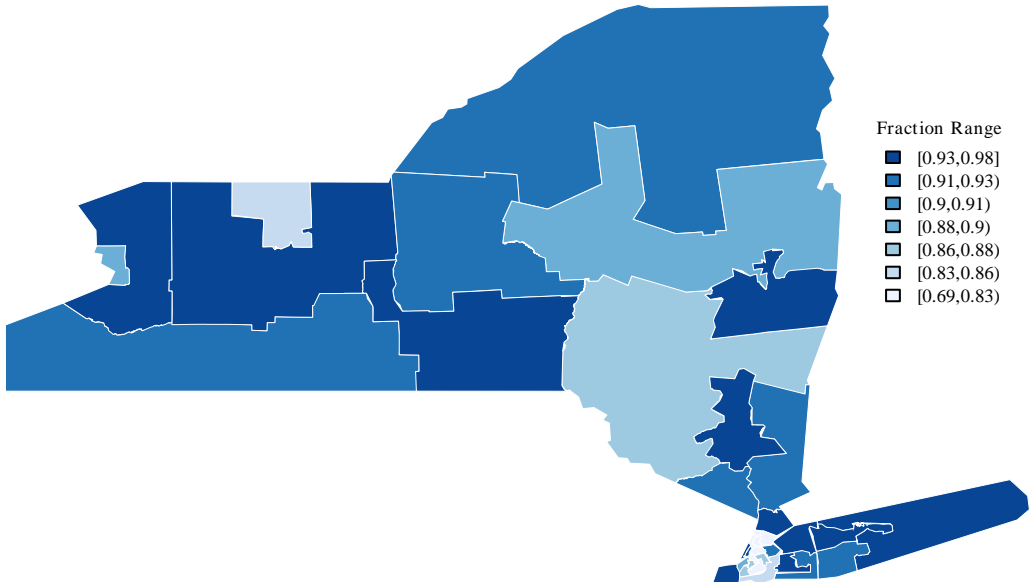

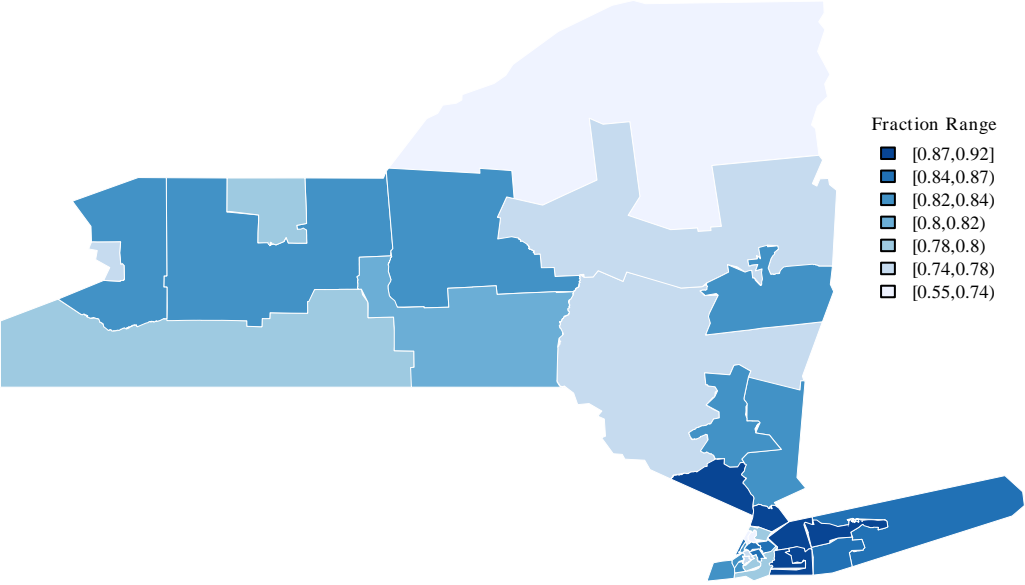
Teenage out-of-wedlock births, fraction of all births



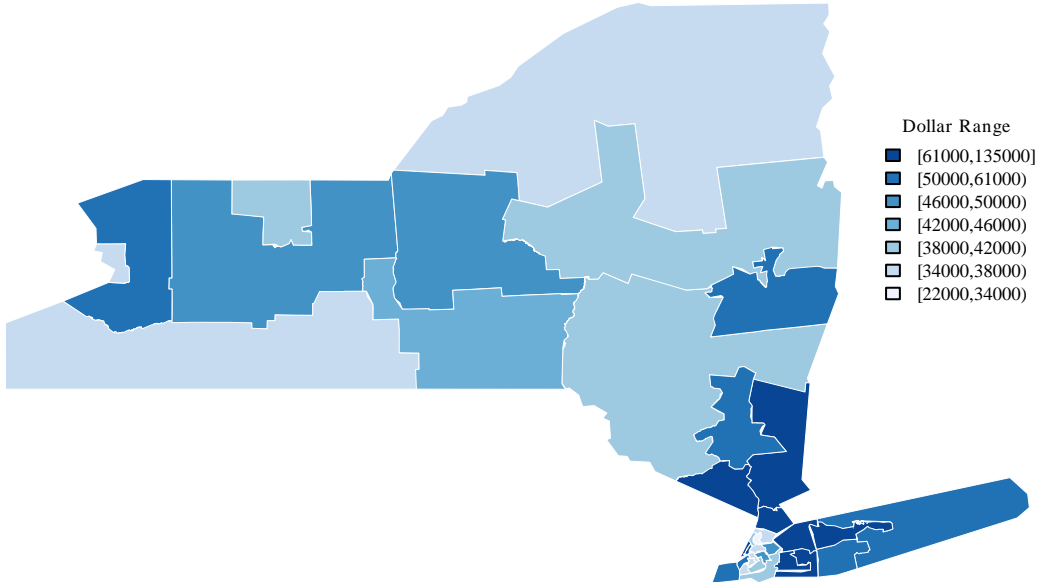

fraction of 25- to 54- year- old men working

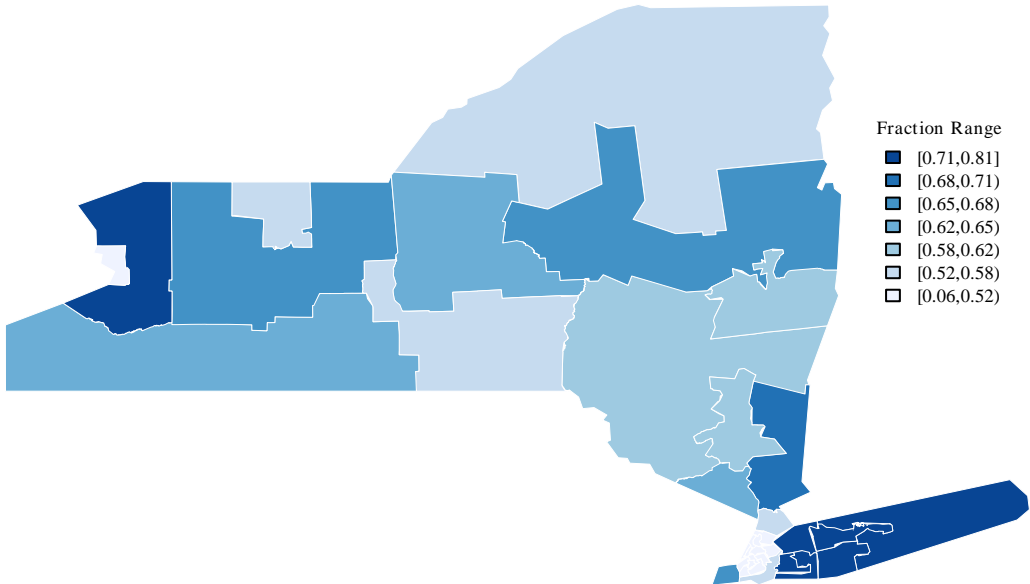


New York Earnings, average per 25- to 54- year- old male



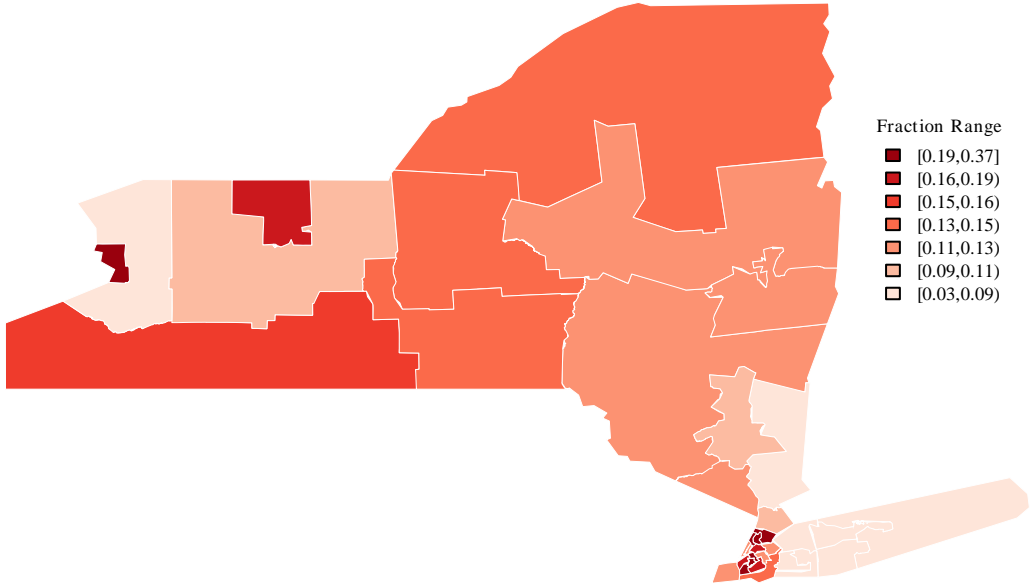

Fraction of households owning home

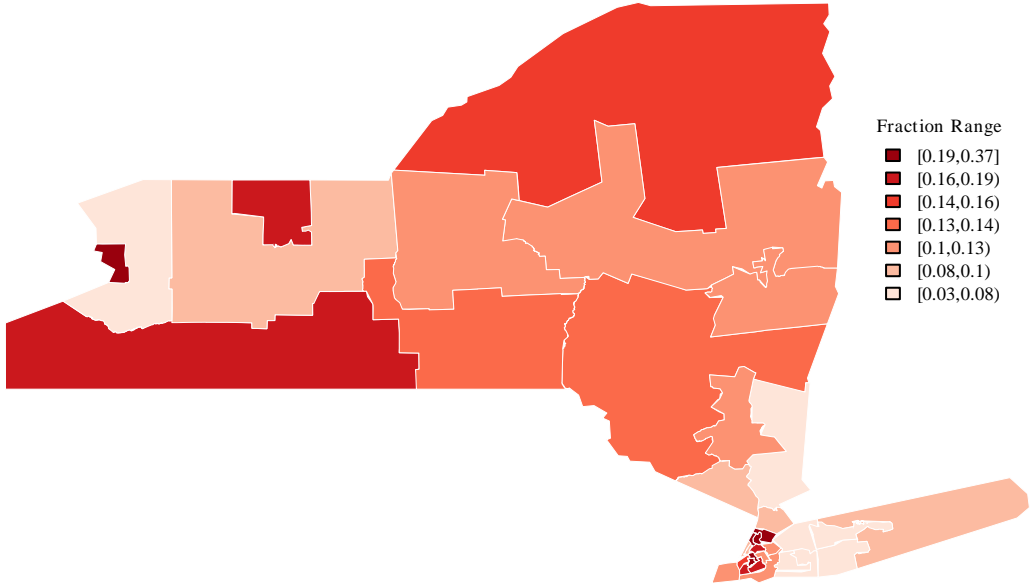

Persons below poverty line, fraction of overall population

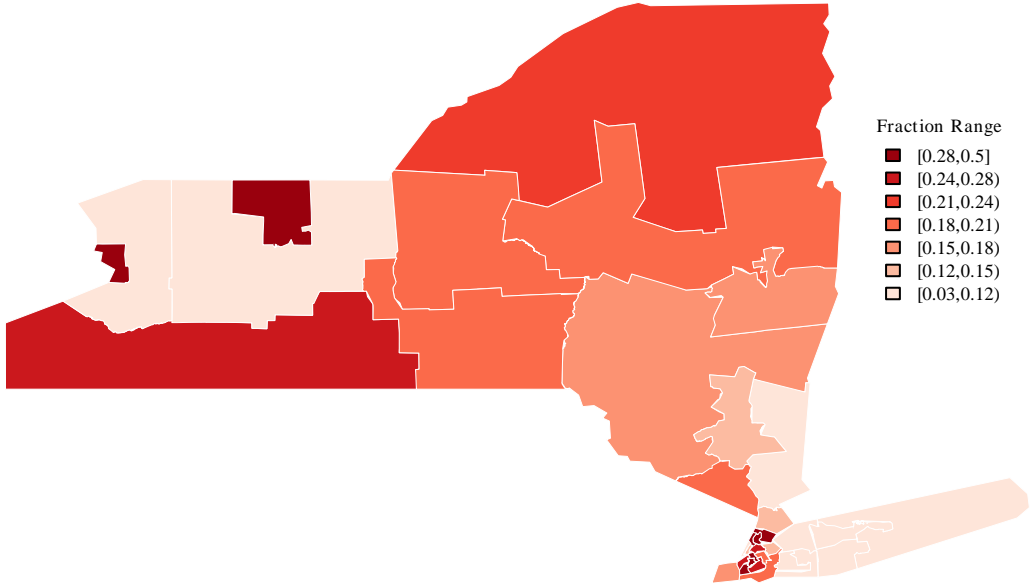

fraction of 25- to 54-year-old females



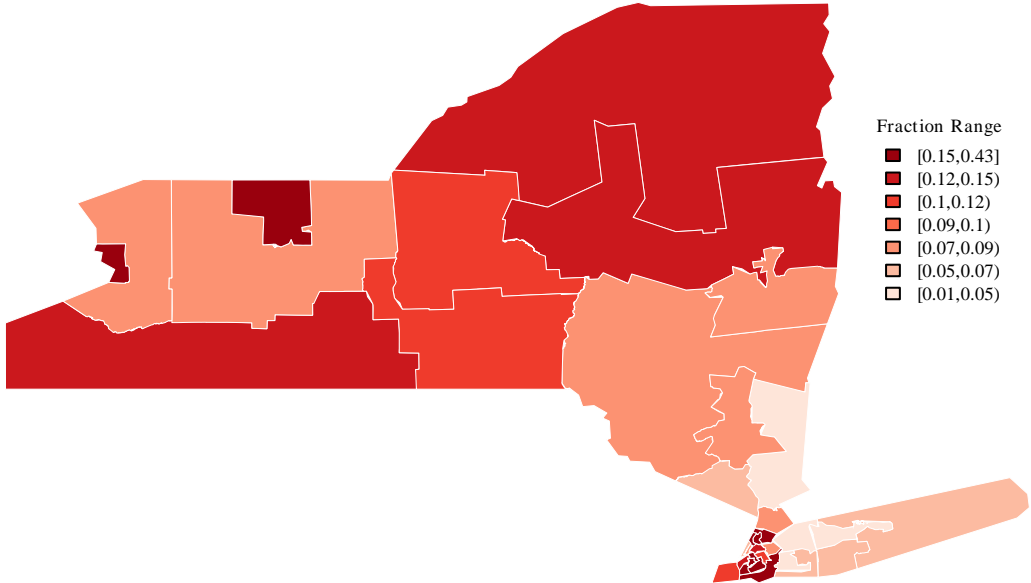

Persons below poverty line, fraction of minors

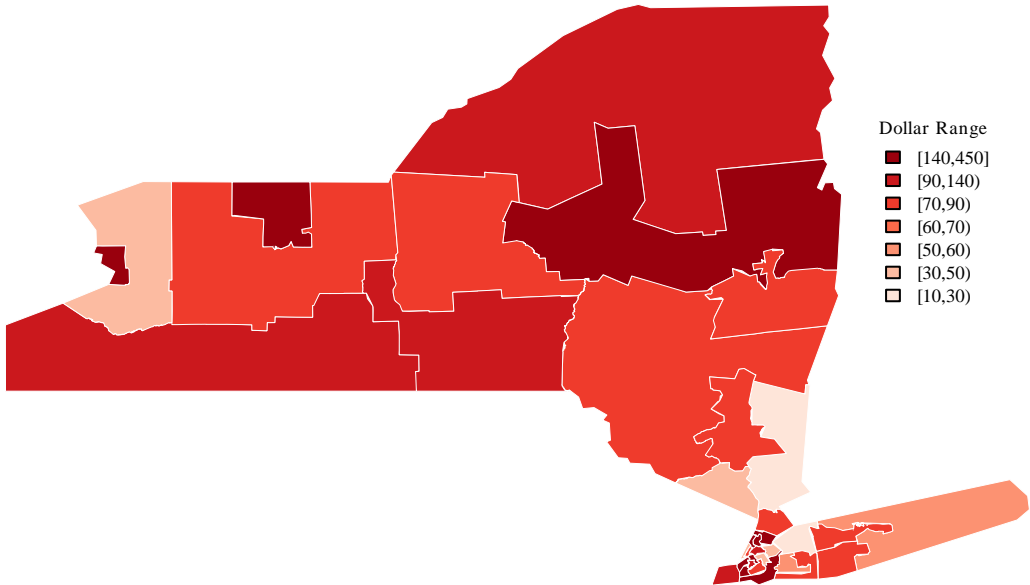

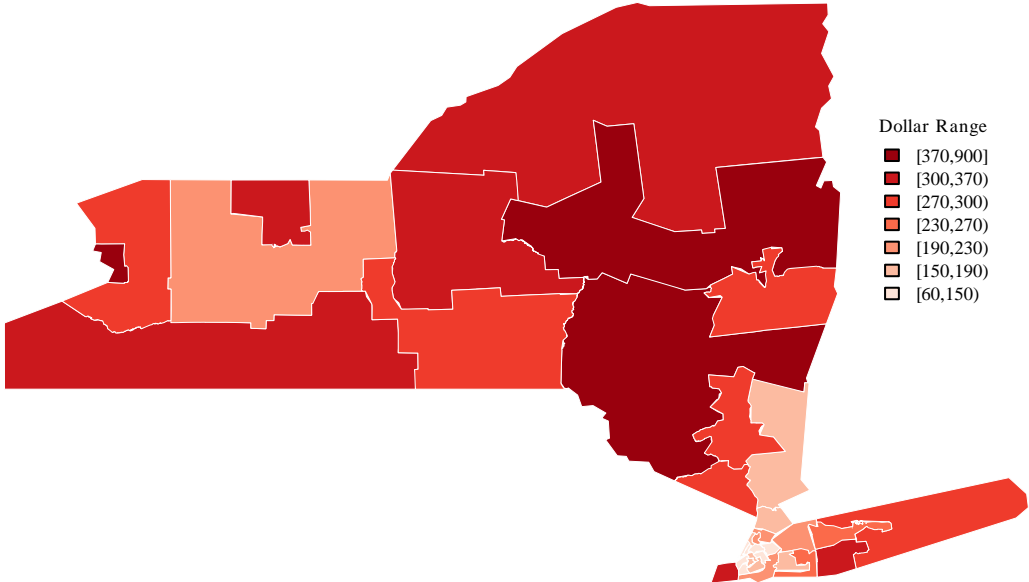
Food stamp recipients, fraction of households



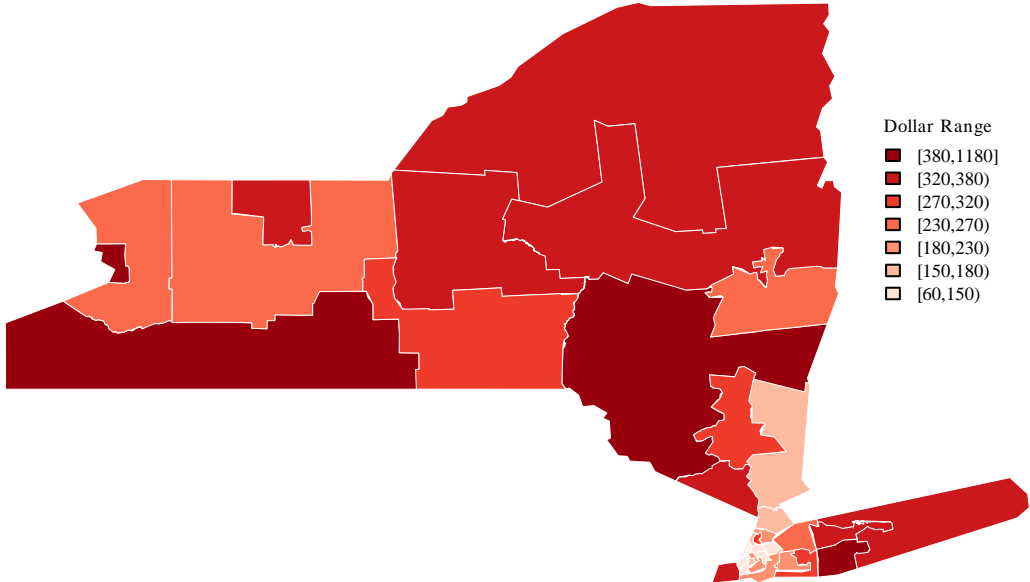

average per 25- to 54-year-old

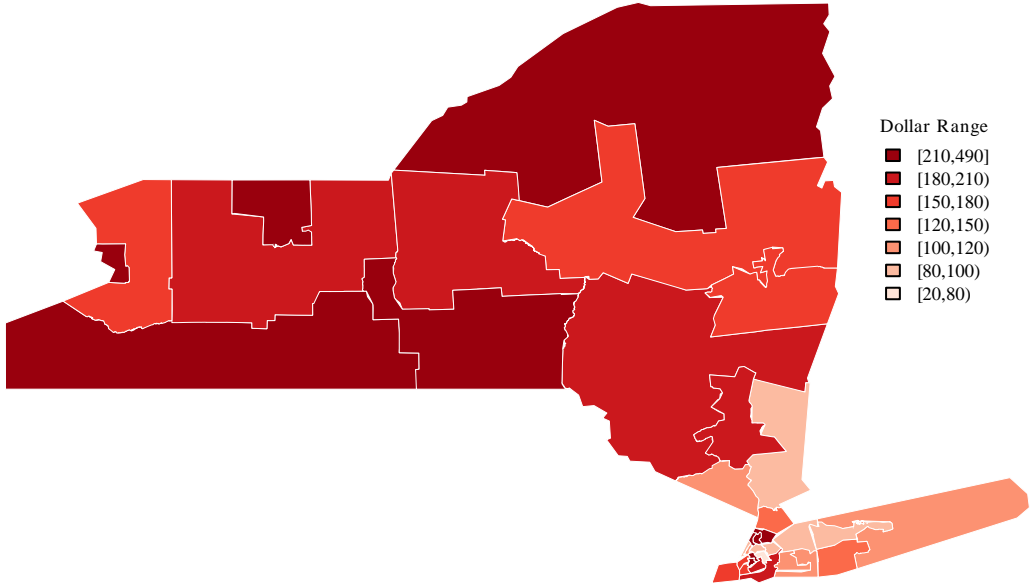

average per 25- to 54-year-old male

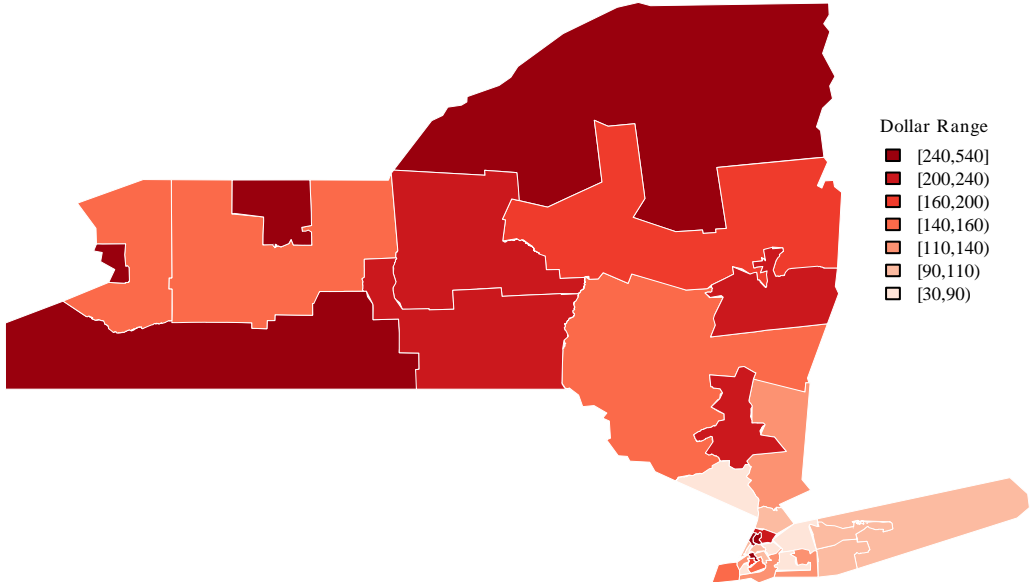

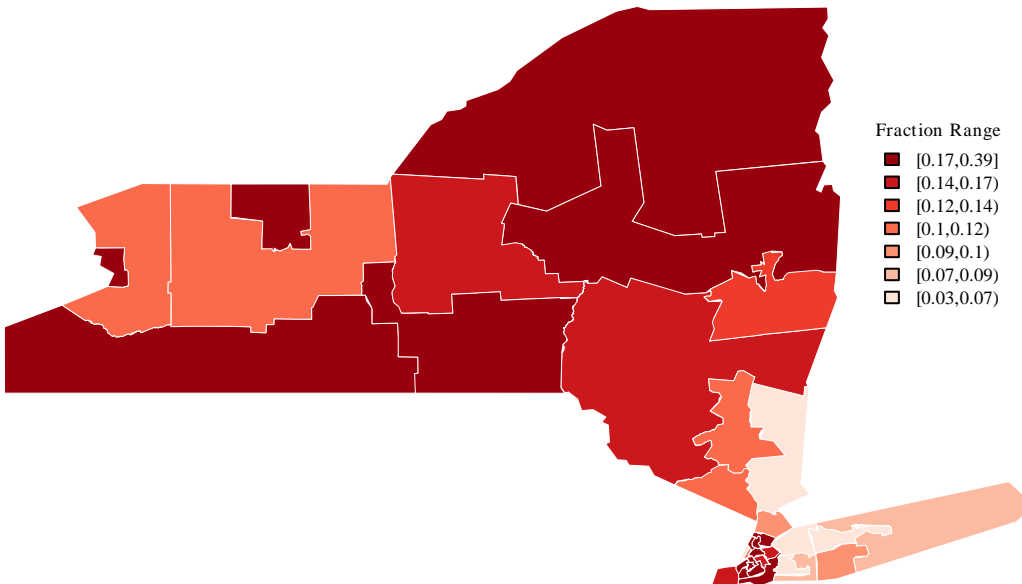
Supplemental Security Income (SSI), average per 25- to 54-year-old male

average per 25- to 54-year-old female

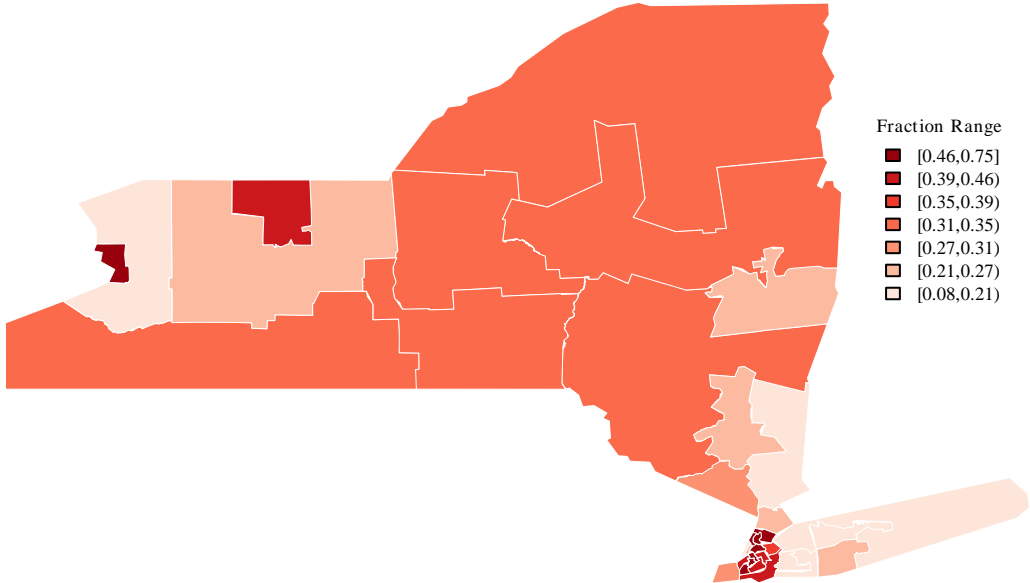

fraction of 25- to 54- year- olds receiving

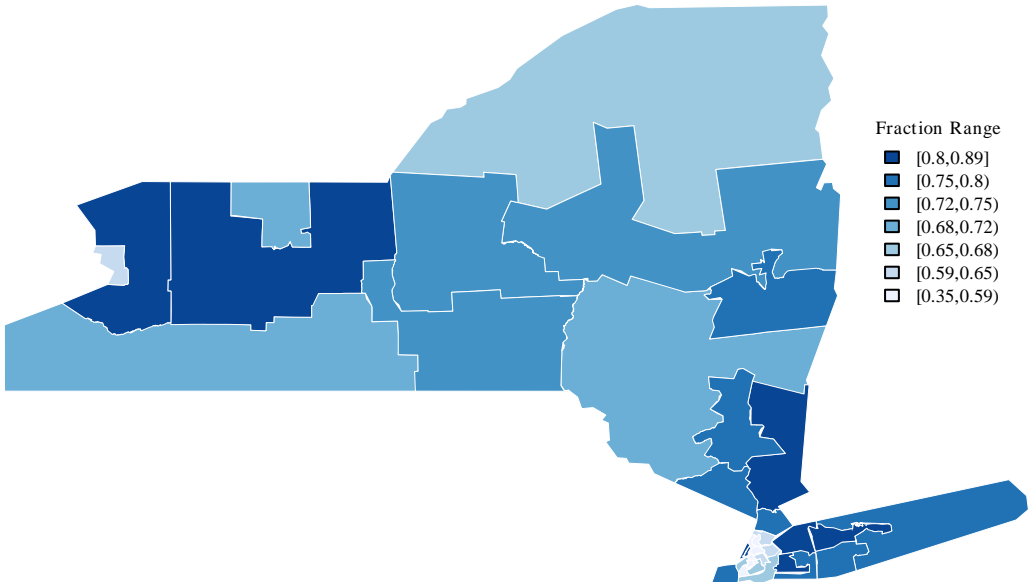
