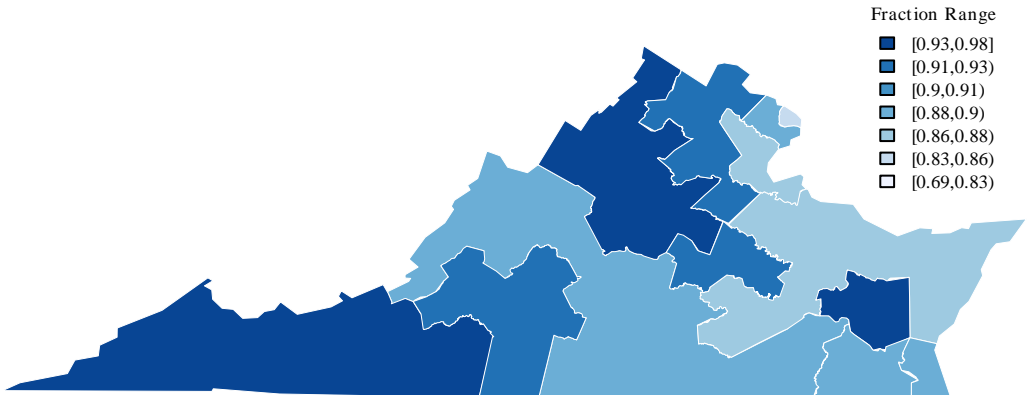

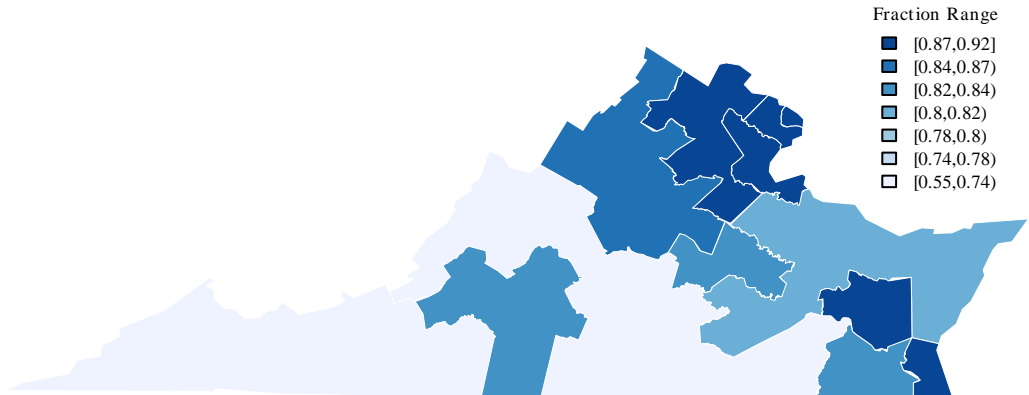




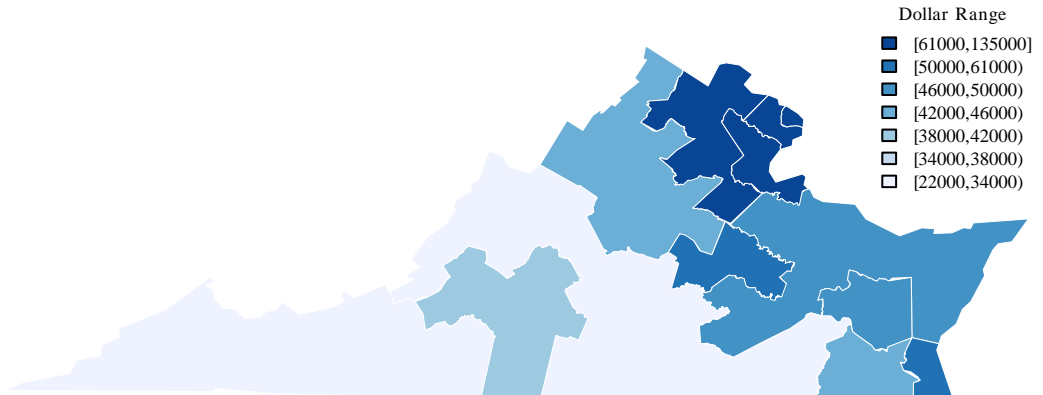

average per 25- to 54- year- old male



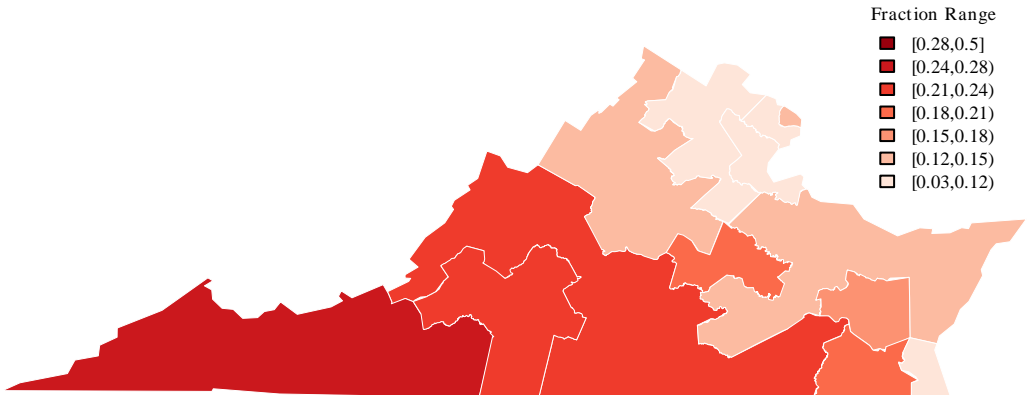






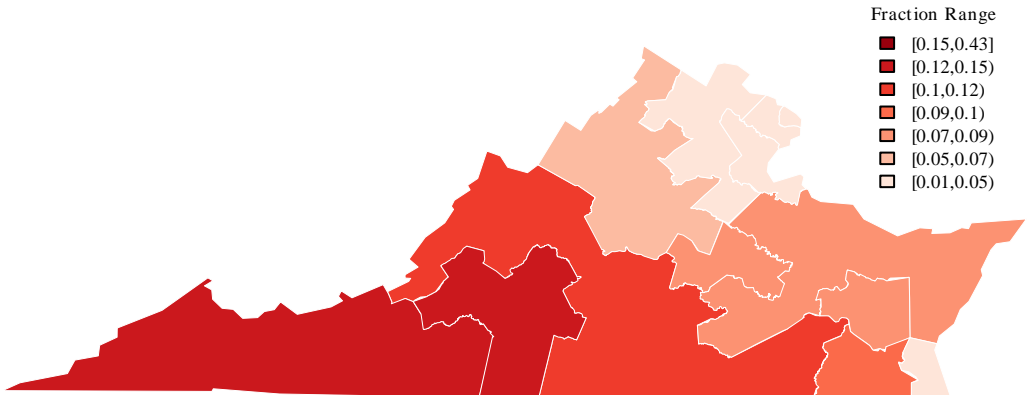

## Persons below poverty line, fraction of minors

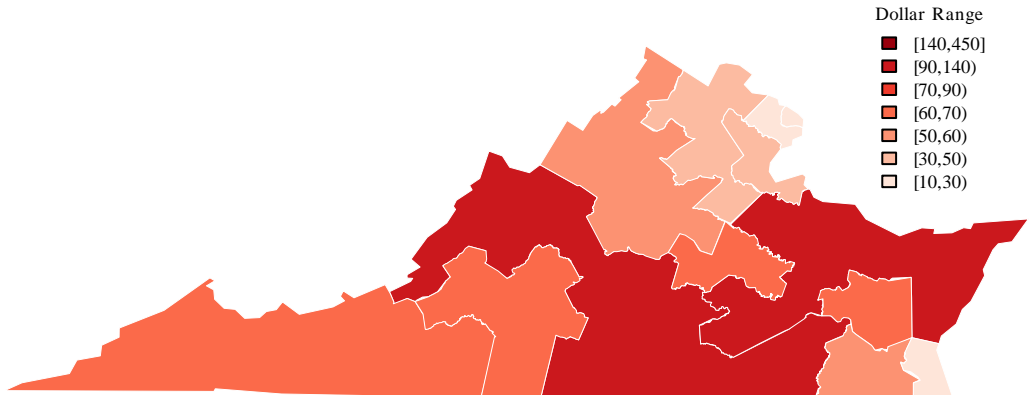

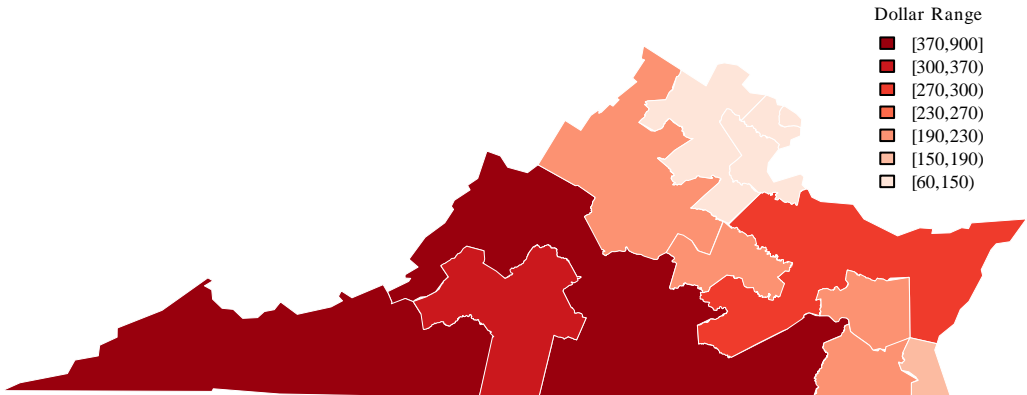

average per 25- to 54- year- old female



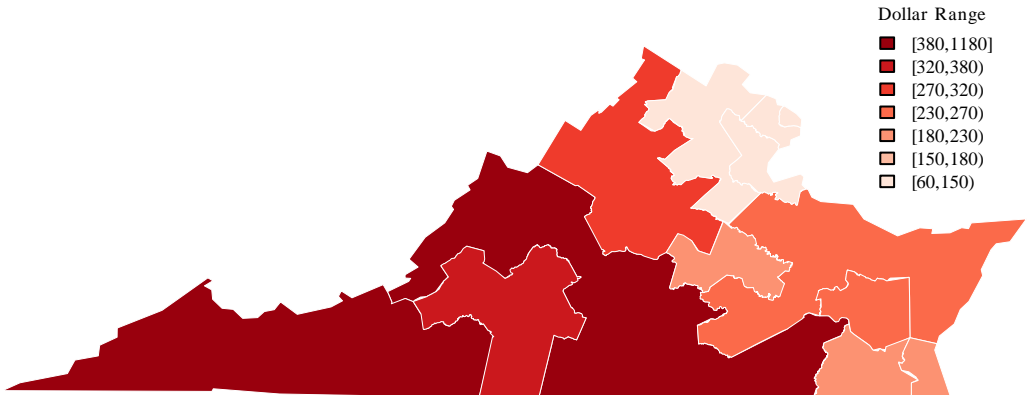

## Social Security Disability Income, average per 25- to 54-year-old



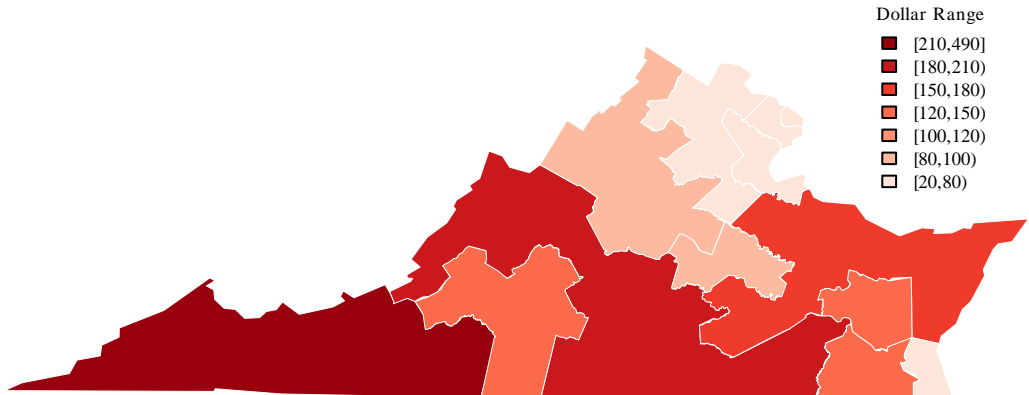

## Social Security Disability Income, average per 25- to 54- year- old male



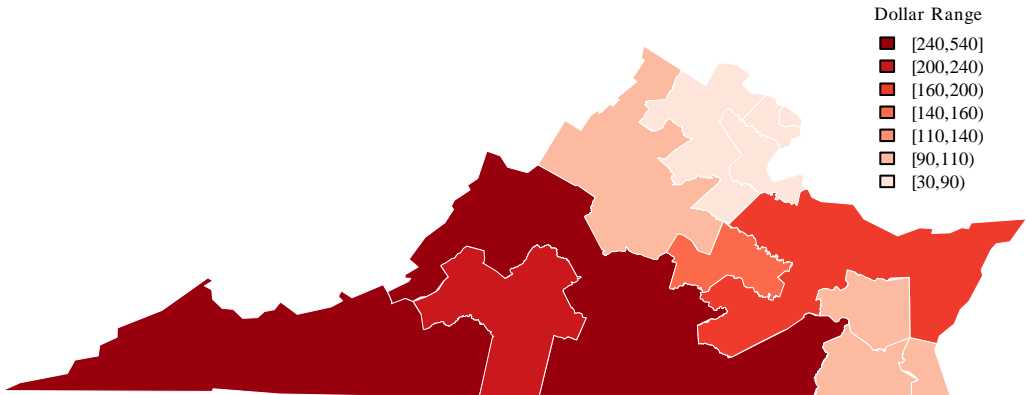

## Supplemental Security Income (SSI), average per 25- to 54- year- old male

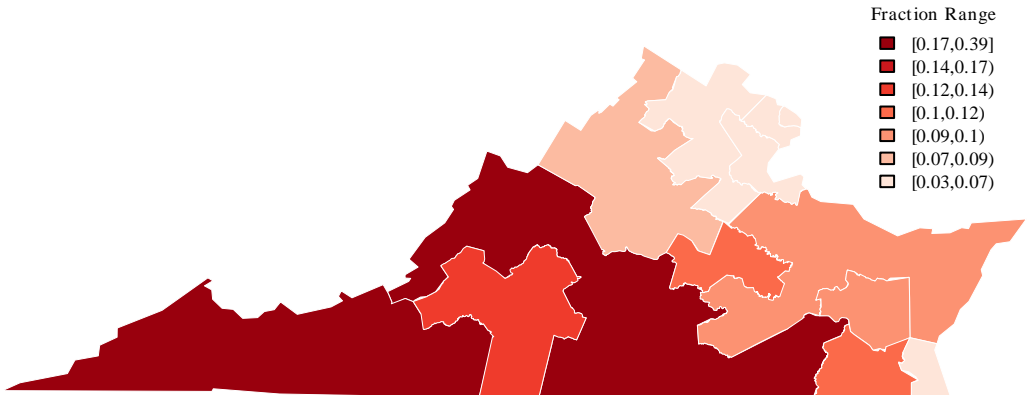
